Groundbreaking for Orlando Virgin Trains

Virgin Trains USA, the first for-profit rail service to launch in the U.S. in decades, says it's on track to begin ferrying passengers between West Palm Beach and Orlando in 2022. In November, British billionaire Richard Branson, head of the Virgin Group of travel companies, announced a partnership with Brightline, a deal that included putting the Virgin name on the company's trains. All Aboard Florida, which operates Brightline, is owned by an affiliate of Fortress Investment Group LLC, a global investment management firm. The South Florida Business Council, consisting of the Greater Miami Chamber of Commerce, Greater Fort Lauderdale Chamber of Commerce, and the Chamber of Commerce of the Palm Beaches have been supporters of the Brightline/Virgin Trains project from its inception.

ADVANCES IN TREATMENT OF ABDOMINAL CANCER DISCUSSED AT JUNE BREAKFAST

Jupiter Medical Center was the presenting sponsored at our June Breakfast. The keynote speaker, Dr. Shanel Bhagwandin, is a fellowship trained surgical oncologist and a board-certified general surgeon. Due to Dr. Bhagwandin, Jupiter Medical Center is the first hospital on the east coast of Florida to perform Hyperthermic Intraperitoneal Chemotherapy (HIPEC) to treat late stage abdominal cancer. There are only a handful of surgeons nationally, who have the skills to perform this procedure.

Attendees were informed that obesity, which causes inflammation, was the leading risk factor related to most gastrointestinal related cancers and that as obesity rates rose nationally, so did the numbers of these cancers reported annually. Dr. Bhagwandin shared: "Except for breast and colorectal cancer, the number of weight-related cancers is expected to increase by 30-40% by 2020" and "Pancreatic cancer is on track to be the second highest cancer-related cause of death by 2020". He added that Jupiter Medical Center used a unique "Multidisciplinary Approach" to treatment via "thorough, highly compassionate, coordinated care, specific to each patient," and a team that included world-class oncologists, radiologists, geneticists, gastroenterologists, pathologists, and nutritionists.

Prior to Dr. Bhagwandin's presentation, Liv Vesely accepted a check for \$1,000 on behalf of the Jupiter Medical Center Foundation. This was donated from the proceeds of the 2019 running of the Chamber's annual Women for Women Road Race, which takes place on Mother's Day weekend.

Young Professionals Learn about Medical Cannabis

Over 40 members of the Young Professionals of the Palm Beaches (YPOP), came out for a "YPOP 411" Educational and monthly Networking Meeting: Medical Cannabis 101. Andrew Burke, Community Educator, from Trulieve and Dr. Jennifer Guthrie and her husband Z. Wilson, of Medclub by Dr. Jenn, were the guest speakers. They gave an overview of the differences between CBD and Medical Marijuana, common misconceptions with Medical Marijuana, and the 12 qualifying conditions required by the state of Florida to obtain a medical prescription. In addition, the group learned about Trulieve on the medicinal properties of over 50 varieties of THC strains in medical cannabis, with names like "Skywalker" and "Purple Punch" and how they may positively impact pain management and moods. The event was also attended by Emily Sullivan, a reporter at The Palm Beach Post who is working on an upcoming feature article on growing businesses that are manufacturing and promoting



the medical uses of cannabis in respect to regulatory and new state laws for 2019 in Florida.
