

There are basically two ways to install DocumentsCorePack from AppSource:

## 1. Get solution from Marketplace in Dynamics 365

It is possible to open AppSource directly from Dynamics 365. Therefore, please navigate to Settings > Solutions and hit the **[Get Solutions from Marketplace]**-button, highlighted in yellow in the figure below.





## 2. Get solution from AppSource


The second option is to go to the AppSource website and search for DocumentsCorePack. Use this [link](#) to find all add-ons provided by mscrm-addons.com (figure below).

Next, please sign into Microsoft AppSource. Enter your e-mail address and hit the **[Sign in]**-button as you can see in the figure below.




Figure 4: Sign in to Microsoft AppSource

In the window below please enter your basic profile information and check the Microsoft permission checkbox at the bottom. Click on the **[Continue]**-button to proceed.




Figure 5: Enter your basic profile information

Next, please enter the Dynamics 365 organization you want to add the solution to, check the checkboxes below and hit the **[Agree]**-button.

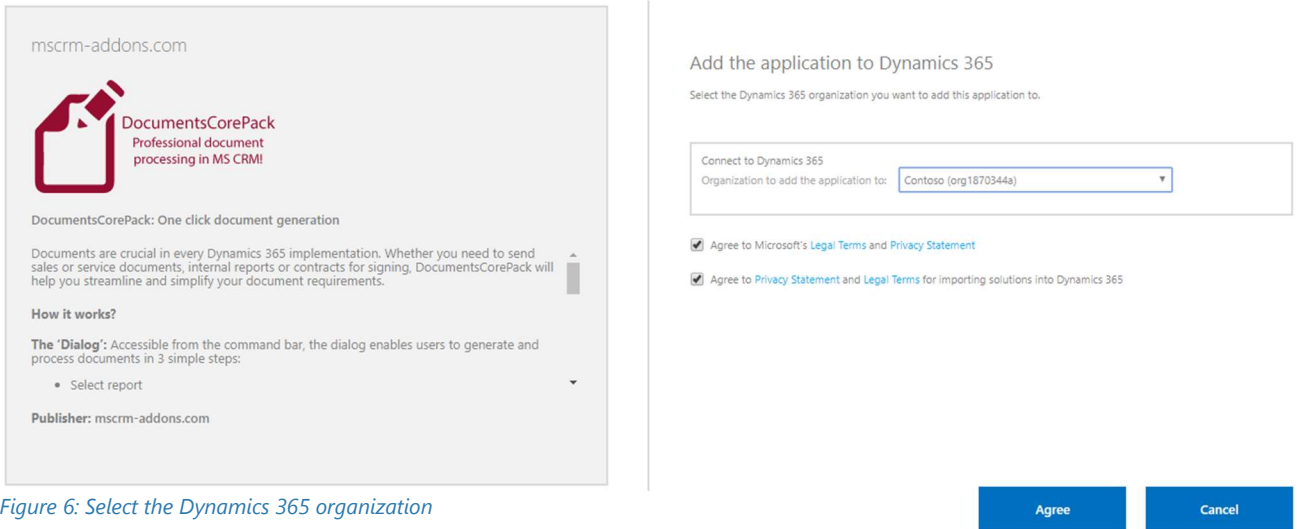


Figure 6: Select the Dynamics 365 organization

This leads you to your organization overview. The installation takes a while – as you can see DocumentsCorePack has the Status “Installation pending” until the installation is completed (highlighted in yellow).

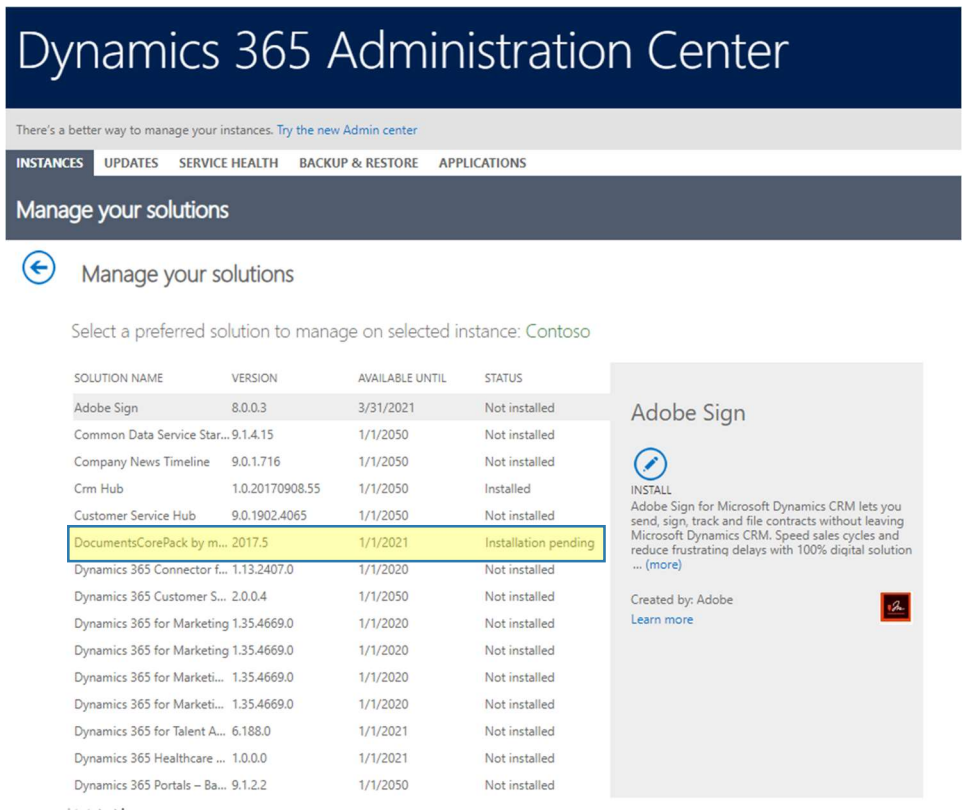


Figure 7: Organization overview – DCP installation pending

Meanwhile, you will receive an e-mail with more information about DCP and its usage.

To see when the installation is finished, please refresh the page in between. Only when the status is on "Installed" you can continue with the process (highlighted in yellow below).

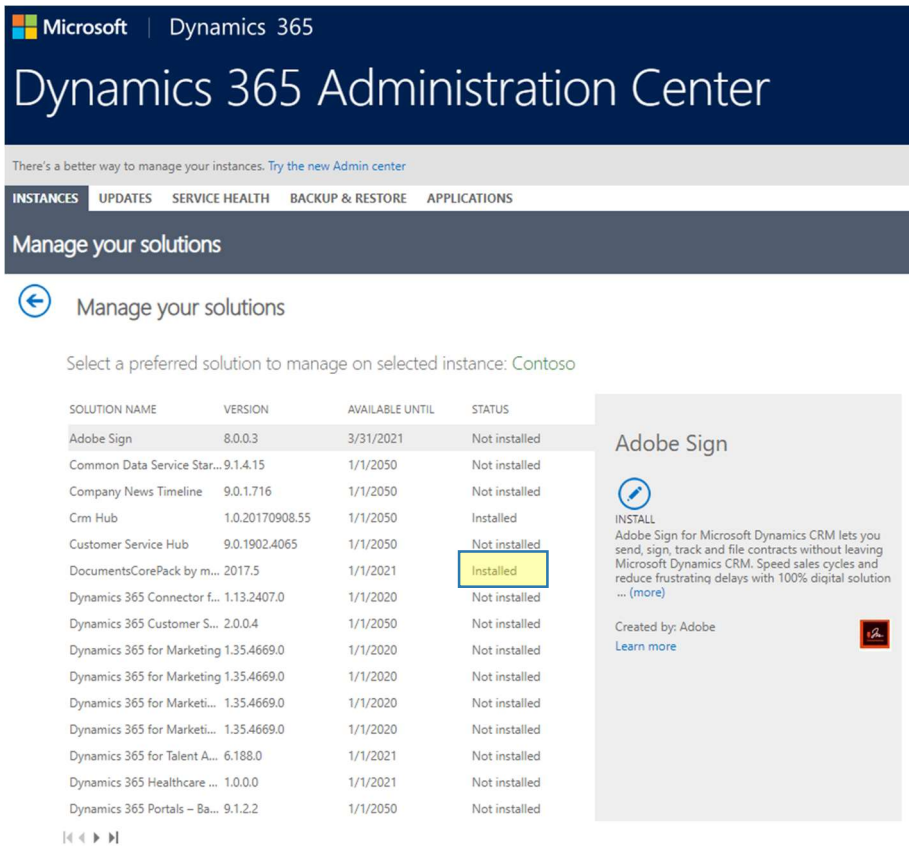


Figure 8: Organization overview – DCP installation finished

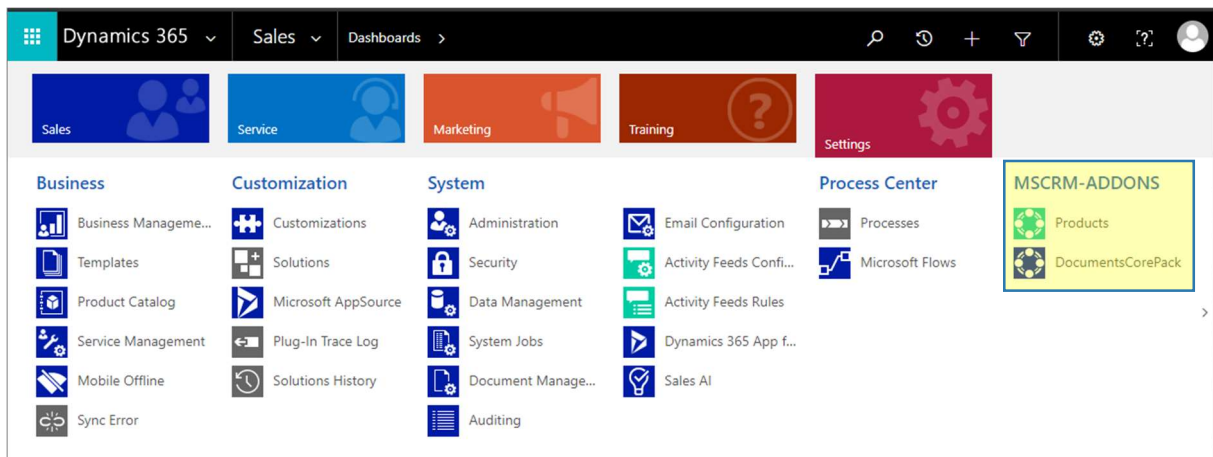


Figure 9: Dynamics 365 Settings > MSCRM-ADDONS: DocumentsCorePack

## DocumentsCorePack Service Setup and Configuration

This wizard allows to provision a document generation service that is required to generate documents. The following steps will be performed upon clicking "Start":

1. **Define connection:** you will be prompted to login with the user that should be used to connect the service with your Dynamics 365 instance.  
Note: Dynamics 365 administrator privileges are required.
2. **Service provisioning:** Once connected our wizard will go ahead and perform the following steps automatically:
  - o Import solutions
  - o Create default settings
  - o Apply security roles
  - o Create service

As you can see in the figure above, you have to log in with the user that should be used to connect the service with your Dynamics 365 instance. Dynamics 365 administrator privileges are required!

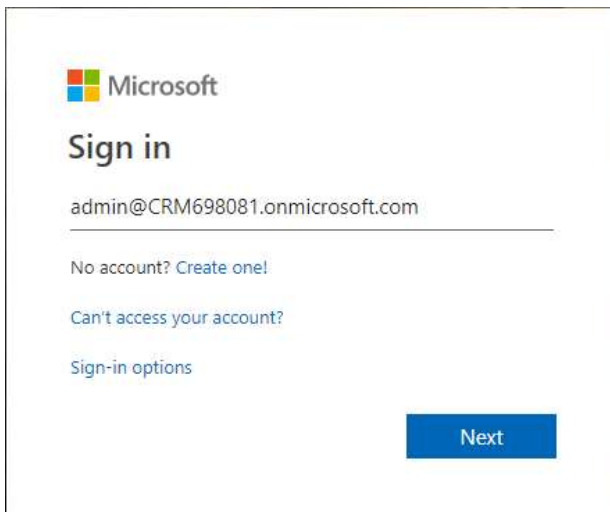


Figure 11: Login with administrator account

Once connected our wizard will automatically import solutions, create default settings, apply for security roles and create a service (see figure 10).

Accept the permissions below by checking the checkbox. With a click on the arrows on the left side, you will get a short description of the requested permissions.

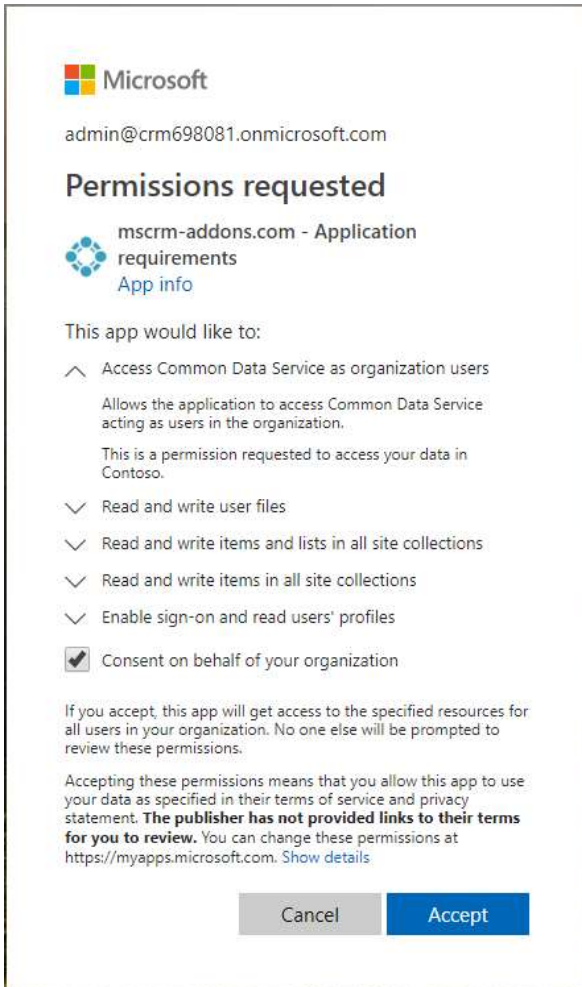


Figure 12: Accept requested permissions

The window below pops up with information on the next steps. This means that you have finished the installation successfully.

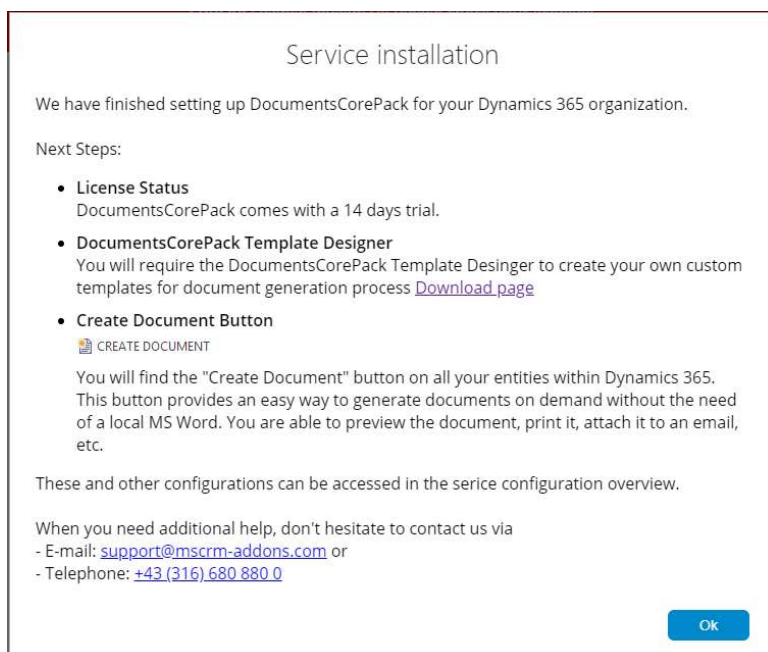



Figure 13: Service installation information

### 3. How to use DocumentsCorePack

Once the Add-On is installed click on the **[Create Document]**-button in the Dynamics 365 Command Bar to generate e.g. quotes and invoices.

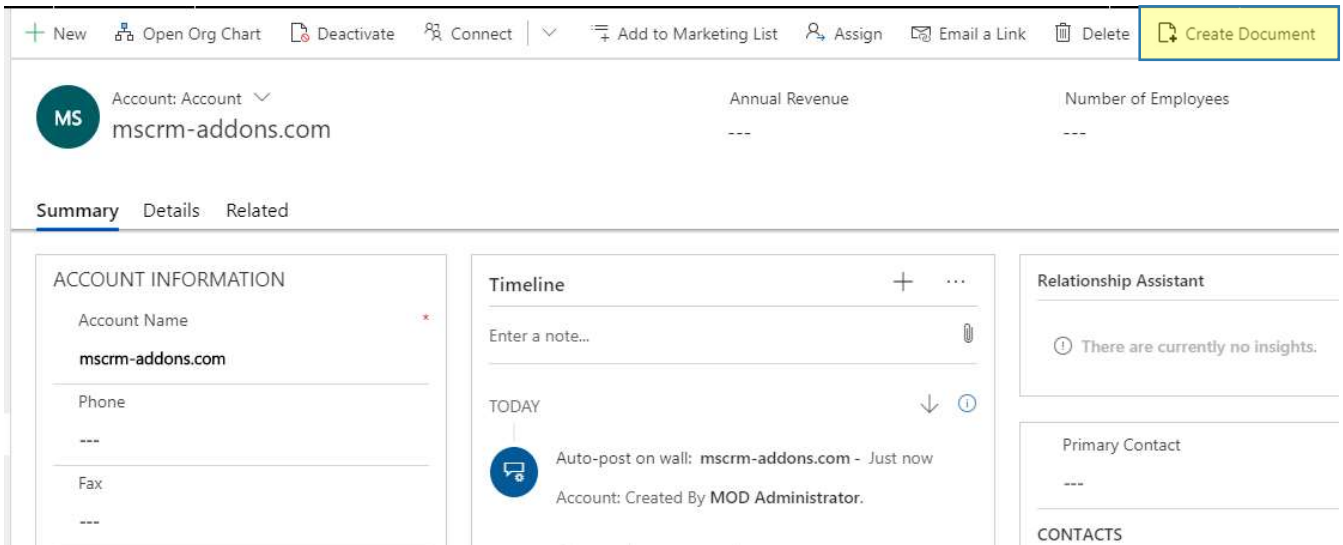


Figure 15: The Create Document functionality

- 1) With a click on it, the DocumentsCorePack Dialog appears. The DocumentsCorePack Dialog is an easily accessible tool to create and process documents directly within Dynamics 365. As you can see in the figure below, six standard templates come with the installation of DocumentsCorePack.

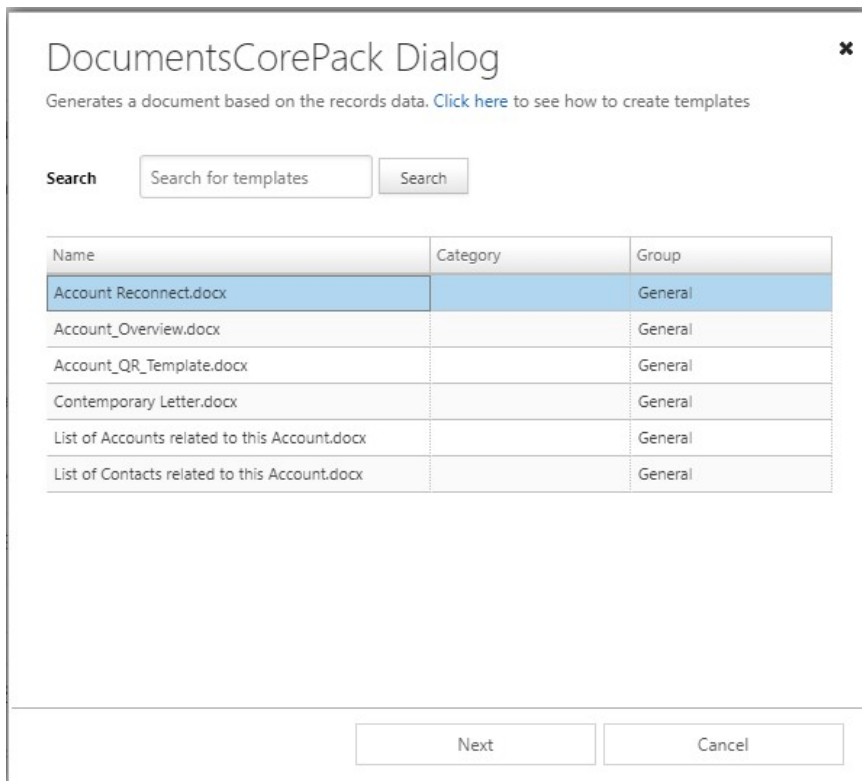


Figure 16: The DocumentsCorePack Dialog

- 2) Choose the appropriate template and proceed with a click on the **[Next]**-button.

- 3) The DocumentsCorePack Dialog contains a set of options. The options vary and change depending on the selections you perform. In this case, you simply generate a document as pdf. Find more information about the DCP Dialog in the [DocumentsCorePack User Guide](#) (chapter 3.2 DocumentsCorePack Dialog options). Click on the **[Next]**-button to proceed.

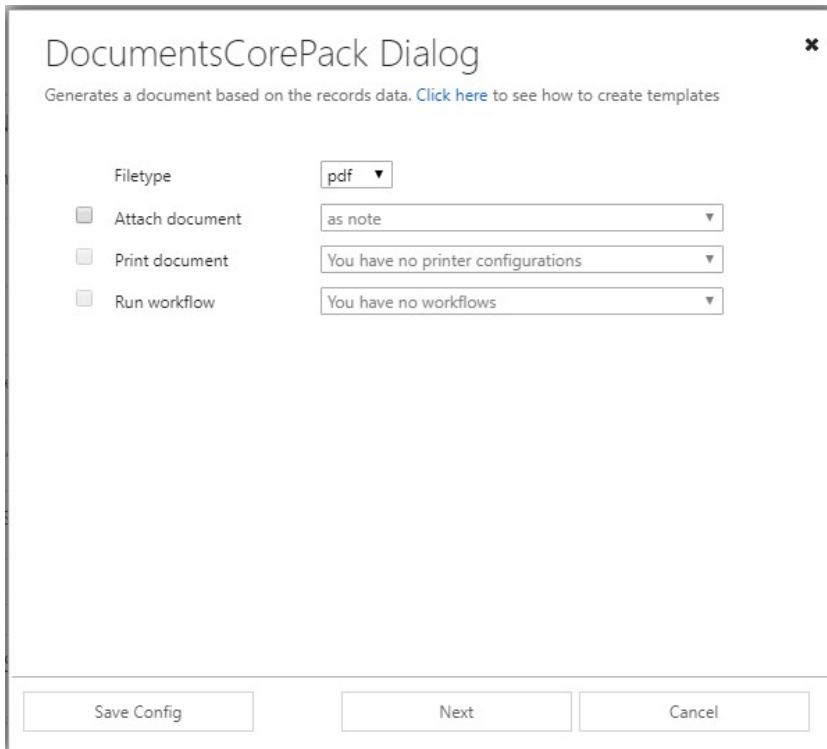


Figure 17: The DocumentsCorePack Dialog options

- 4) Before finishing the process, it is possible to preview the document by hitting the **[Preview]**-button, highlighted in yellow below.

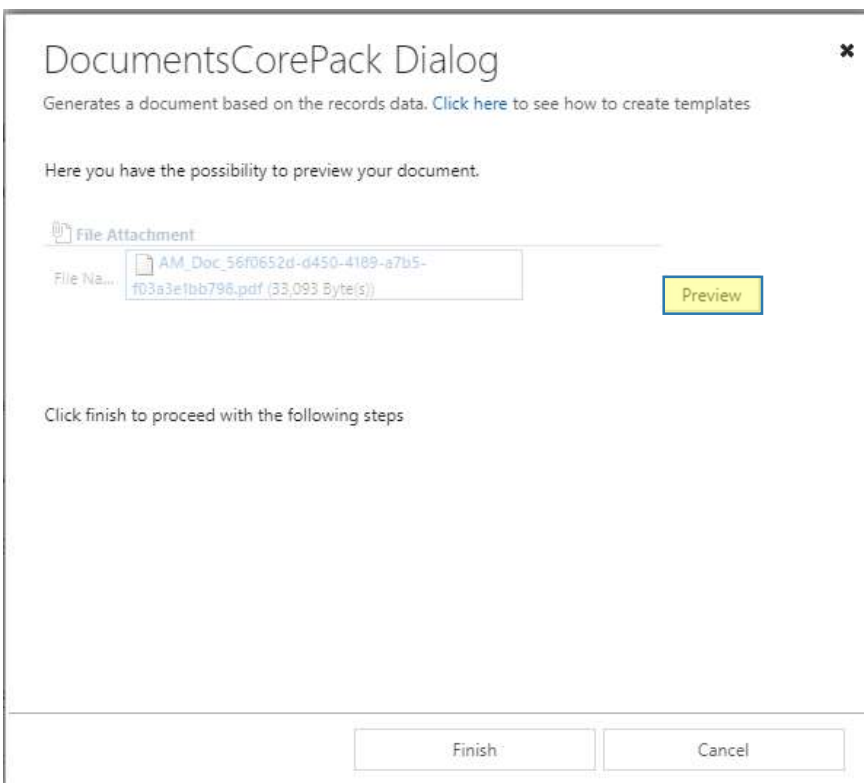


Figure 18: The DocumentsCorePack Dialog: Preview document

- 5) Next click on the **[Finish]**-button to complete the process. Congratulation, as you can see below, you have created your first document.

The Template Designer will help you to create templates for each Microsoft Dynamics 365 entity (for example Contact, Account, Opportunities ...).

The DCP Template Designer can be easily accessed via the [www.mscrm-addons.com](http://www.mscrm-addons.com) – tab in the Microsoft Word command bar, as you can see in the figure below, and provides you with a lot of options that facilitate the creation of templates.

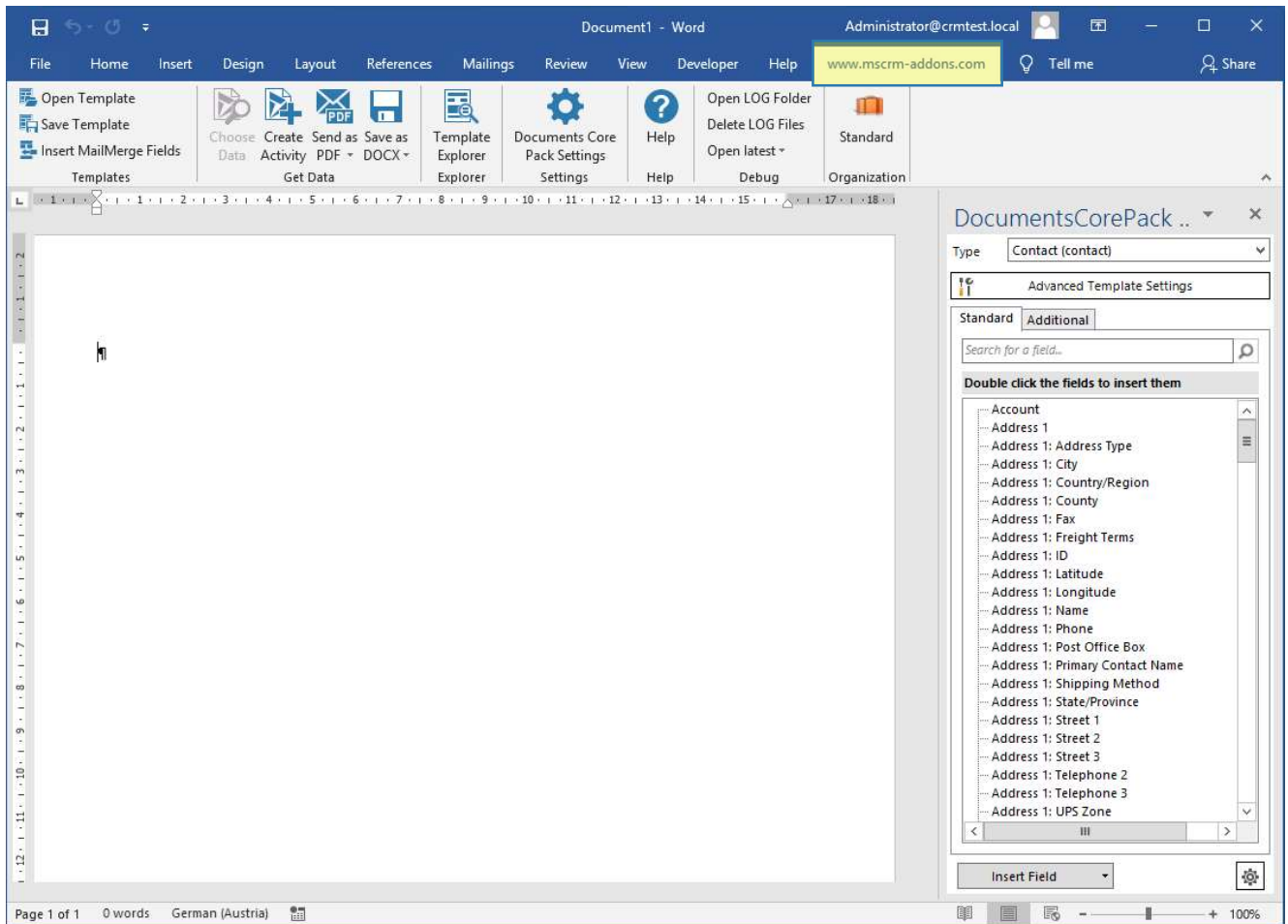


Figure 20: Microsoft Office Word with mscrm-addons ribbon
