The Pasco Association of Educators will offer five (5) \$1,000.00 scholarships for qualified High School Seniors to assist them in furthering their learning and to promote academic achievement. These scholarships will be awarded to seniors who plan to enroll in an accredited program.

The first \$1,000.00 scholarship will be awarded to a current Pasco School District senior, whose parent(s) are PAE member(s), and who plan to enroll in a program that results in a teaching degree.

The second \$1,000.00 scholarship will be awarded to a current Pasco School District senior, who plans to enroll or major in education.

The third and fourth \$1,000.00 scholarships will be awarded to two (2) current Pasco School District seniors whose parent/legal guardian is a member of PAE and plans to enroll in an accredited two or four year vocational or academic program.

The fifth \$1,000.00 scholarship will be awarded to a current senior attending a public school or private school in another district as long as one parent/legal guardian is a member of PAE.

If the applicants meet all basic criteria on the application and there are not enough applicants to award all the scholarships in a particular category, then the committee retains the right to award a scholarship from another category at their discretion. Final selection will be based upon the scoring rubric.

The scholarship will be awarded the second quarter or semester of attendance following graduation from high school. The college registrar must directly send to PAE: Official verification of current full time enrollment and an official transcript for the previous quarter or semester. PAE will then send the scholarship check. Recipients must notify PAE as to the best mailing address for the funds. If no other address is indicated, the scholarship will be mailed to the identified college by default.

*Term Limit – Scholarship must be claimed within 12 months of High School graduation.

Special circumstances will be considered within the 12 month period of High School graduation.

Application Requirements: Document must be typed. Hand written applications will not be submitted to committee.

- 1. Submit all the following
 - a. 250-500 word essay of your career goals: Why have you chosen them? What have you done to lead up to this career goal?
 - b. 250-500 word essay: Upon completion of your post High School education, how do you plan to contribute to your community to make it a better place.
 - c. List Activity Record during High School: (include both <u>school</u> and <u>community</u> activities; such as leadership, senior project and/or volunteer work)
 - d. List Honors and Awards during High School: (include both school and community)
- 2. A current official transcript with a minimum cumulative G.P.A. of 2.5.
- 3. Two (2) letters of recommendation in sealed envelopes;
 - One from a school faculty member
 - One from any non-school district employee, non-related adult
- 4. Completion of Application (page 3)
