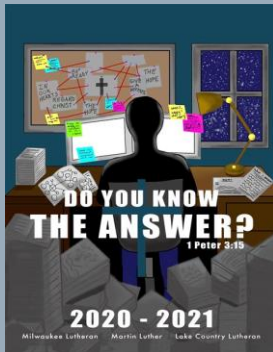

LCL COVID UPDATE

[This update is a reminder of how LCL is currently operating in person, and it serves as a simple reminder to reiterate some of our existing procedures. We are thankful to those in the community who have abided by the necessary precautions, and we are grateful that our community has been successful in mitigating risks to allow for in-person instruction.]

LCL is praying for all those in our community to be safe and maintain good health. As of right now, **LCL continues to offer instruction in person on our campus.** LCL will continue to mitigate risks to provide students with the overall school experience here on campus if we are able to maintain that process. In our ministry, we are also committed to supporting our students in their overall well-being mentally, emotionally, and spiritually. In addition to academic experiences, the in-person educational experience provides opportunities for additional mentoring, support, and stability that is more conducive in a face-to-face environment on campus.

communicate that information to the LCL office. Even before COVID concerns emerged, LCL has always worked with students and families in situations of short-term or long-term absence from class. Using Schoology and other communication tools, LCL teachers will continue to support students and work directly with students when absences from class might be necessary. For a variety of educational and privacy reasons, full virtual options are not individually available.

Rest assured, **LCL is in direct communication with the Waukesha County Health Department.** Of course, we will continue to watch the trends in our community carefully and work directly with the Health Department in determining the safety of in-person school on our specific campus at LCL. If there is a need for our specific campus to close for the overall health and well-being of the LCL community, we will work and cooperate with the Health Department to do so and then we would temporarily switch to online delivery of Remote Learning & Instruction if needed. Please note that, if a temporary switch to Remote Learning & Instruction is necessary, that adjustment will occur throughout the entire student body for all classes and all students for a determined time period. **In the case of a school-wide temporary switch to Remote Learning & Instruction, students should be prepared to login to classes throughout the regular 8am – 3pm school day.** In such circumstances, the LCL teachers will connect with students during specifically scheduled times to help maintain the relationships that are so crucial to our ministry, and LCL would explore ways to safely offer extra-curricular opportunities.

We will continue to pray for safety, good health, and continued ministry here with our students and families!
