6. Further affiant sayeth naught.

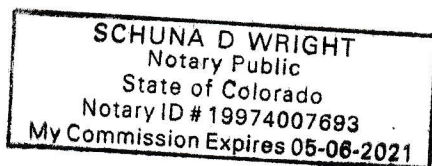
