GOVERNMENT AFFAIRS

The passing and proposal of many new bills will directly and indirectly affect our members and their customers.

Peoria County – Peoria County has released its 2020 budget. It is available to view online at <https://www.peoriacounty.org/395/Budget-Information>.

"I'm satisfied with how our budget came together," says Peoria County Board Chairman Andrew A. Rand. "After seeing projections on lower equalized assed property values and the numbers coming in from the Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund, we were still able to present a balanced budget without raising property taxes."

The budget as recommended has \$129,539,894 in revenues and \$133,648,229 in expenditures. The budget fully funds Peoria County's IMRF (pension) obligations while keeping Peoria County's property taxes flat. Due to reduced property values, Peoria County's share of the tax bill will go down from what was paid in 2019. Additionally, 2020 will see a reduction in the size of payroll, which will be largely achieved through attrition within the organization.

With the \$45 billion Rebuild Illinois capital plan underway, Gov. Pritzker signed legislation to aid new workers. The Illinois Works Jobs Program makes \$25 million available to community-based organizations to recruit new apprentices. Additionally, the program provides goals that, on projects costing \$500,000 or more, apprentices will make up no less than 10 percent of the workforce. One of the primary goals of this legislation is to encourage and spur diversity in the trade professions as only contracts that host expenditures to businesses owned by minorities, women and persons with disabilities may count towards the goals of the Act. Systemic fund sweeps of Illinois' gun regulation administration funds are questioned as gun-related programs suffer from delays and challenges. Illinois continues to face a series of corruption probes.

New Laws Effective January 1

Minimum Wage

Earlier this year, SB1, the "Lifting Up Illinois Working Families Act," was passed by the Illinois General Assembly and signed into law by Governor JB

Pritzker. Over the next five years, the minimum wage will increase from \$8.25 per hour to \$15.00 for workers 18 years and older. For employees who are under 18 years of age who work less than 650 hours in a year, the minimum wage will increase from \$7.75 to \$13.00 during the next five years.

Cannabis

Effective January 1 recreational adult use (21) cannabis will be legal in Illinois. It will also be available for purchase at retail outlets in Illinois. How will Illinois employers deal with cannabis possession and usage in the workplace?

Other Impacts

Employers should ensure that contracts with employees entered into after December 31, 2019 that contain confidentiality provisions are compliant with the Workplace Transparency Act. Effective January 1, the Illinois Victims' Economic Security and Safety Act ("VESSA") is amended to include victims of gender violence (as defined in the law), providing the same leave entitlements as victims of domestic or sexual violence.
