OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Press the power button once to turn on. To adjust heat setting, use the + or - button. The curling iron has reached your selected temperature when the numbers on the LED or digital display screen begin to flash. To maintain a desired heat while using, press and hold the temperature lock button. A padlock symbol will appear in the LED screen when this option is in use. To release the temperature lock, press and hold the button until padlock symbol disappears from the LED screen. Once you have finished curling, press the power button to turn off and unplug the tool. This iron is intended for professional and consumer use. This iron has a polarized plug (one blade is wider than the other). As a safety feature. this plug will fit into a polarized outlet only one way. If the plug does not fit securely, reverse the plug. If it still does not fit. contact a qualified electrician. Do not attempt to defeat this safety feature.

- Take small sections of hair for optimum results

- Check the cord and surface of the cord. Never use if any parts are cracked, split, torn or damaged. Check the plug and never use if it is cracked, split or
- damaged. Check the plug pins and never use if transformed or
- damaged. Check the controller and do not use if cracked, split, broken or damaged.

When not in use, clean and dry the entire iron and store in a cool, dry place.

When readv to use, follow the directions for daily maintenancé. Daily Cleaning: To keep barrel clean, unplug the iron from

the power source, and once the barrel is cool, wipe down barrel after each use with a hot, damp towel. WARNING: Do not wipe the iron with thinner, benzene. gasoline, lamp oil, and other solvents or chemicals, as that may cause accidents or malfunction and may damage the

iron and void the warrantv.

Defects and Malfunction:

 - The iron is covered under warranty for 12 months from the date of purchase.
