Once in the app you will be able to follow the results, access the official noticeboard and event updates.

#### Where to find the official notices

#### Familiarise yourself with the Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions

The NOR and Supplementary Sailing Instructions have been posted on the MSC website, on the official event app. We recommend all sailors and support people read these thoroughly.

#### We have a COVID-19 management plan

Please use the contact tracing app while at the event. Scan in upon arrival each day using one of the QR codes around the club, turn on your Bluetooth for contact tracing purposes. There are manual sign-in forms available in the clubhouse if you do not have the app on your phone (although we do recommend you download it).

#### At a minimum please:

- Ensure that you record your attendance at this event
- Consider 2m physical distancing and wearing of a mask or face covering if you prefer
- DO NOT attend if you are feeling unwell or have been in close contact with someone confirmed with COVID-19 in the past 14 days
- Practice good hygiene and ensure your sailors practice good hygiene, use soap to wash your hands thoroughly and there will be hand sanitiser around the club for your use as well
- Alert race officials if you become unwell during or soon after the event so we can implement our Covid-19 response plan.

We will continue to monitor any Covid-19 updates and make the necessary adjustments to our regatta plans if necessary.

All entries will be close at 2100 hrs on Monday 29<sup>th</sup> March.

An entry list is published on the MSC website & Event App – please check to make sure your details including name(s), class, sail number etc are all correct. If any equipment needs to be changed post entry, please notify the Club on <a href="mailto:admin@maraetaisailingclub.org.nz">admin@maraetaisailingclub.org.nz</a>. Notifications must be made prior to registering at the event.

### Sailing Boat Storage

Overnight security will be in place in the Boat Park (Maraetai Park) from Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> April. Clubs &/or individual sailors wishing to train at Maraetai in the build up to the Regatta can leave their boats on the hard stand outside the MSC Sheds in the main Boat Club area.

We do ask that all Opti's are taken over to Maraetai Park by 1000 on Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> April. Club Rib's can also be left over night in this area during the build-up but please contact Jason Higgott (021) 865 492 in advance.

#### **Parking**

There is parking available:

- Public Carpark outside Boat club gates
- Along Maraetai Drive
- On the corner of Maraetai Drive and Rewa Road (next to Coastguard)

### Storage of Opti Road Trailers

Trailers can be stored during the Regatta in the compound on Dr Adah Platts-Mills Reserve off Maraetai Drive (Adjacent to the Coastguard Building). This storage compound will be available from 1200 on Wednesday 31<sup>st</sup> March.

# Official Boats, Club & Support Rib's & Boats

Upon arrival at Maraetai please drive into the Main Boat Club grounds. Please advise event staff if you are delivering an official boat or un-manned club loaned boat as these will be parked separately. You will be directed to where to leave the boat. The Parking Team will have the Support Boat Safety Packs including boat tags with them. Boats that have been pre-registered will have also been pre-allocated a mooring line to tie on to each night.

Boats will be launched for you and either taken out to the Mooring lines or temporarily stored inside the breakwater on the first race morning. Rib & Boat trailers will be stored in a compound over on Maraetai Park. Once launched, boats can be retrieved but it is a bit of a mission.

We will have capacity to launch and retrieve larger trailer boats each morning and night. These can be stored overnight in the Breakwater Parking area.

#### **Mooring System**

KYC have once again loaned us their Mooring System. As weather through Easter can be a little less predictable than experienced for recent Auckland Champs, we will be strictly managing the number of boats on each string. Your mooring location (either on the strings) or inside the breakwater will be clearly identified in the support pack you will be given following registration of your support boat. Pre-registering boats online will more likely guarantee a mooring spot.

We will have overflow Marina berths available at Pine Harbour Marina if we are unable to accommodate all boats close to the Club. Pine Harbour Marina is a 20-minute trip further up the coast.

Nb. Boats trying to tie onto mooring strings &/or in places not pre allocated will be removed and anchored in the Bay.

On the last day of racing, it is a big task to systematically bring all boat trailers back from Maraetai Park and then retrieve boats. We will be calling boats into the Breakwater when we have the matching trailer ready for retrieval. We do not want boats trying to jump the queue and enter the breakwater until they are called up. This only causes frustration for everyone and slows up the process.

### Daily Washdown

Washdown facilities will be set up each day on the Public Ramp/Helipad area. This is a busy public ramp so please follow the instructions of the MSC crew so that the queues are not blocking other ramp users.

In an emergency, we need to be prepared to vacate the Helipad quickly.

### Bring your NZIODA tag – we're using electronic sign on / off

We'll be using an electronic QR code system for sign on and off the water.

- Bring your tag we're using electronic sign on/off
- We'll be using an electronic QR code system for sign on and off the water
- If you have not yet been provided with a QR code tag you will be issued with one at registration
- There is a \$10 charge for issuing of a new QR code tag if you forget your existing tag

#### There are no credit card facilities

Please note that we will have Eftpos available for cash transactions only, we do not accept credit card or

provide 'cash out' facilities. We accept cash payments as well.

#### Register your support boat

All support and coach boats are requested to have VHF communications and be available to assist the race committee if required. Please complete a radio check with MSC tower to confirm your presence on the water; channels are:

- Opti Green (Course A channel 17)
- Opti Open and White (Course B channel 77)

All support vessels shall always have a kill-cord attached to the driver while the engine is running.

### Results and prizegiving

Results will be posted within 'results' in the regatta app.

The official prizegiving will take place as soon as possible after the last race on the last day of the regatta.

#### For your safety

**First aid:** Our first aid station is located at the main race office in the boat club building. Cecelia Chote (Ph 021 914 765) will be present in the first aid area each day and is our health and safety contact during the regatta.

### Be efficient when you drop off your boat

The best place to drop off boats and equipment upon arrival is the side of the helipad adjacent to Maraetai Park. Please minimise the time you remain parked in this area and then move your vehicle in to a public carpark or side of the road.

### Stow your beach trailer appropriately

Parents, after sailors are launched, please help to keep the beach tidy by tightly grouping all trailers immediately to the East of the public boat ramp — that's to the right when facing the sea. All beach trailers should be clearly identified with the sail number — thank you for your assistance with this as we do share our beach with swimmers, especially over the Easter weekend.

# Boat Park Etiquette

There is lots of space over on Maraetai Park to store your boat and rig up. Please respect the clear zones which are marked on the ground and in particular the set back from the main coastal walkway. This is a busy area, and we need to share and not impose on other users.

# Rig Racks Marquee

Please feel free to utilise the rig racks in the Marquee on Maraetai Park.

#### You're welcome to enjoy our clubhouse

You're welcome to enjoy the Clubhouse during this regatta. Our catering zone will be adjacent to the sailing Club sheds will be open for refreshments and we'll have a barista on site – so bring your keep cup. Sailors change rooms are available in the Public toilets in Maraetai park and the portable showers can also be used. Please keep showers to a minimum – as we're on tank water!

It's hot out there - please remember to bring a refillable and reusable water bottle and stay hydrated. A water refill station will be positioned near the food area.

Our awesome catering team will be available for refreshments as per the published programme. See the TeamApp. Hot and cold drinks are available throughout the day and our Clubhouse Bar will open from 1400 each day.

# Care for your environment

We know we don't really need to say this, but please look after our beach and water environment. Put your litter in the bins. Tie drink bottles to your boat. Leave only your footsteps. We encourage sailors to use refillable water bottles and coffee drinkers to bring a keep-cup for their coffee. There will be a water refill station across the main entrance drive from the main boat club building. Single use plastic bottles will not be available for sale.
