Because it was in '83 that we rolled out our original batch of bikes, including the classic Outback pictured here. Finally, the Novara ideal had been forged into steel. Our philosophy? We believe that you have certain inalienable rights, among them: the right to travel without a combustion engine, the right to ride an ultra-comfortable bike, and the right to wear a big ol' grin the whole dang time. We held those truths to be self-evident a quarter-century ago. And we still do today. We pledge on our honor and on the Novara logos inked over our hearts that we'll stick by them 'til the end.







Our designs start with sensations. Like the stomach-tickle that accompanies a mad downhill run. Or the rush of joy that arises as one swoops through an asphalt curve. We hit "pause" on the feelings, and then our design begins. We build bikes to fit those freeze-framed moments, one component at a time. We lavish on the tech, not just for tech's sake but for the good of the ride. We anguish over colors and graphics like wrench-turning Van Goghs. When it's all good, we hit "play." And that's where you come in: beaming a megawatt smile, yelling "yeehaw!" and just plain enjoying the ride.



Novara only christens women's bikes after they pass a crucial rite of passage. They must get the thumbs-up from our posse of hard-riding female field testers here at Novara World Headquarters. And boy, do those gals love to hammer our prototypes—helping the designers make sure geometry, components and fit are totally dialed for the feminine physique. None of us here could be happier with our '07 lineup of women's bikes. Particularly the women, who have been out riding them pretty much nonstop since they arrived at the shop. Looks like the guys get to mop up all the smashed champagne bottles out back.

### How to size your Novara bike

- 1. With shoes on, measure from your crotch to the floor. This gives you your inseam length.
- 2. Find the stand-over height (A) on the Novara geometry chart above.
- 3. For mountain, touring, urban and comfort bikes, the difference between your inseam length and the stand-over height should be around 2"; for road bikes, this difference should be around 1".
- 4. If you're between sizes, select a larger frame if you prefer a more comfortable upright riding style; select a smaller frame if you prefer a lower, more aerodynamic riding style.

At Novara, we believe that if you follow your heart you can't help but end up in a good spot. That philosophy guides the way we design bikes and the way we do business.


