

Donation Policy

PLEASE DO NOT PLACE DONATED MATERIALS IN THE BOOK RETURN BOXES.

Donations will be subject to the library's collection policy. Any item that is not added to the library collection will be sold in the Friends annual library book sale to generate funds for Beaumont Public Library System services and programs.

Donations Accepted:

Adult and Childrens books, textbooks, media materials (DVD/Bluray, music CD's, books on CD, games, vinyl records, etc.) in good conditon. Other materials may be accepted but will be at the discretion of the library branch managers and administration.

Donations Not Accepted:

The library cannot accept damaged materials, incomplete media sets, magazines, vhs or cassette tapes, encyclopedia sets, and anything of a graphic nature.

Where to Donate:

Patrons wishing to donate items should contact the library before dropping them off to make sure the library currently has space to store the donation. The library asks that the donated items be delivered in small boxes or bags that can be easily lifted and carried.

Other Donations:

Many library users wish to make donations in the form of memorial items. Please contact your local branch manager or the library administration at 409-981-5911 on this giving opportunity. Monetary or in-kind donations on behalf of the library should be made directly to the Beaumont Public Library System.
