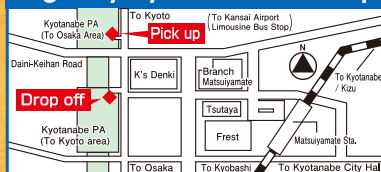

(In some cases, a bus without a restroom may be in service.) 6.Please store large pieces of luggage in the trunk room. Please limit use to one suitcase per person (no charge). Please store and remove the luggage by yourself. 7.Ticket refunds are limited to unused tickets within the valid period (Only round trip outbound tickets which are not used and still valid. For round trip set tickets, all portions must be unused and within the valid period.) [Reminders] 1.When riding the bus, please be sure to fasten your seatbelt. 2.Smoking is prohibited inside the bus. 3.Please refrain from talking on mobile phones while on the bus. 4.Please avoid food and beverages which may disturb other passengers (strong smelling food, large quantities of alcohol). 5.Please do not bring pets on board. 6.Please keep your valuables and small items with you on the bus.
