Xsan and Media Administration Certification Programs

Apple’s Xsan and Media Administration certifications verify an ability to install and configure systems, architect and maintain networks, customize and troubleshoot services, and integrate Final Cut Studio, Final Cut Server, and other Mac OS X technologies within an Xsan installation of any size.

Xsan Administrator certification is granted upon passing the Xsan Administration exam. To earn Apple Certified Media Administrator (ACMA) certification, students must pass three required exams based on Mac OS X Server, Final Cut Server, and Xsan, plus one elective exam.
