Applicant Eligibility Criteria:

The applicant must be a *Dependent Child* of an active employee of Timpte, Inc. (David City, Customer Support Centers and Colorado) or Thunderstone Manufacturing, LLC (Lincoln and Lake Ozark) at the time of the award.

Dependent Child is defined as a biological or stepchild who is financially supported by an active employee and is no older than 24 years of age at the time of the application deadline.

The applicant must be accepted into a *Qualified Academic Program* which includes a 4-year Bachelor's Degree, 2-year Associate's Degree or 2-year Vocational Degree. The degrees must be offered from any accredited US-based University, College or Community College system.

The applicant must be accepted as a full-time student and registered for a minimum of 12 credit hours per semester.

Application Submittal Guidelines:

Applicants meeting the above eligibility criteria must submit a *Fully Completed Scholarship Application* which includes the attached application along with the following items:

- **Recommendation Letters:** Two sealed letters of recommendation <u>from non-family members</u>. Examples include, but are not limited to, one from a high school or college teacher and one from a supervisor at an employer.
- An Official Transcript: The transcript should include GPA, SAT and/or ACT scores, and class rank. The purpose of the transcript is to verify GPA and the candidate's progress through their educational program.

The *Fully Completed Scholarship Application* (including essay, transcript and letters of recommendation) <u>must</u> be received by a committee member by midnight on **March 1, 2021** (the *Submittal Deadline*). Timpte's Scholarship Committee will review all submissions and schedule a personal interview with those applicants who have advanced to the final round of review and selection.

The applicant will not be considered for this scholarship unless their Fully Completed Scholarship Application is submitted before the above-referenced Submittal Deadline. Applicants are encouraged to refer to the checklist on the last page of this application.

Scholarship Awards:

The funds will be paid directly to the college or university attended, per information provided by the scholarship recipient containing verification of registration, college name, and mailing address.
