

Global Asthma Network (GAN): Asthma Content

The Global Asthma Network was established in 2012 out of a collaboration between the International Study of Asthma and Allergies in Childhood (ISAAC) and the International Union Against Tuberculosis and Lung Disease (The Union). The network includes 285 centers in 120 countries with a purpose to improve asthma care globally, with a focus on low- and middle-income countries, through enhanced surveillance, research collaboration, capacity building, and access to quality-assured essential medicines.
