**SKILL LEVEL**: Easy

SIZE: One Size

Set of 3, each about 10 in. (25.5 cm) in diameter.

#### **MATERIALS**

- 482-157 Lion Brand Recycled Cotton: Sunshine
  - 1 Ball (A)
- 482-130 Lion Brand Recycled Cotton: Seagrass
  - 1 Ball (B)
- · 482-123 Lion Brand Recycled Cotton: Sand
  - 1 Ball (C)
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook Size H-8
- Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

#### **GAUGE:**

19 sc = 4 in. (10 cm). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. If it takes you less stitches and rows to make a 4 in. [10 cm] square, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

#### NOTES:

Yarn amount is sufficient to make one of each washcloth.

## **COLOR SEQUENCE**

Washcloth 1: A, B, C Washcloth 2: B, C, A Washcloth 3: C, A, B

#### **WASHCLOTH**

With first color in Color Sequence, ch 4; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, work 6 sc in ring; join with sl st in first sc.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 1, turn, 2 sc in each sc around; join with sl st in first sc – 12 sc.

Rnd 3: Ch 1, turn, \*sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from \* around; join with sl st in first sc - 18 sc.

Rnd 4: Ch 1, turn, \*sc in each of next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from \* around; join with sl st in first sc - 24 sc.

Rnd 5: Ch 1, turn, \*sc in each of next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from \* around; join with sl st in first sc – 30 sc.

Rnd 6: Ch 1, turn, \*sc in each of next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from \* around; join with sl st in first sc - 36 sc.

Rnd 7: Ch 1, turn, \*sc in each of next 5 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from \* to last 2 sc, sc in each of last 2 sc; join with sl st in first sc - 42 sc.

Rnd 8: Ch 1, turn, \*sc in each of next 6 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from \* to last 2 sc, sc in each of last 2 sc; join with sl st in first sc – 48 sc.

**Rnd 9:** Ch 1, turn, sc in each of next 6 sc, 2 sc in next sc, \*sc in next 7 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from \* to last sc, sc in last sc; join with sl st in first sc – 54 sc. Fasten off.

Join 2nd color in Color Sequence with sl st in same sp.

**Rnd 10:** Ch 1, turn, sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc, \*sc in next 8 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from \* to last 4 sc, sc in last 4 sc; join with sl st in first sc - 60 sc.

**Rnd** 11: Ch 1, turn, sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc, \*sc in next 9 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from \* to last 8 sc, sc in last 8 sc; join with sl st in first sc - 66 sc.

Rnd 12: Ch 1, turn, sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc, \*sc in next 10 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from \* to last 8 sc, sc in last 8 sc; join with sl st in first sc – 72 sc. Fasten off.

Join 3rd color in Color Sequence with sl st in same sp.

Rnd 13: Ch 1, turn, sc in next 6 sc, 2 sc in next sc, \*sc in next 11 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from \* to last 5 sc, sc in last 5 sc; join with sl st in first sc – 78 sc.

Rnd 14: Ch 1, turn, sc in next 9 sc, 2 sc in next sc, \*sc in next 12 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from \* to last 3 sc, sc in last 3 sc; join with sl st in first sc – 84 sc.

Rnd 15: Ch 1, turn, \*sc in next 13 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from \* around; join with sl st in first sc - 90 sc.

Rnd 16: Ch 1, turn, sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc, \*sc in next 14 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from \* to last 10 sc, sc in last 10 sc; join with sl st in first sc – 96 sc.

Rnd 17: Ch 1, turn, sc in next 6 sc, 2 sc in next sc, \*sc in next 15 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from \* to last 9 sc, sc in last 9 sc; join with sl st in first sc – 102 sc.

Rnd 18: Ch 1, turn, sc in next 14 sc, 2 sc in next sc, \*sc in next 16 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from \* to last 2 sc, sc in last 2 sc; join with sl st in first sc – 108 sc.

Rnd 19: Ch 1, turn, sc in next 13 sc, 2 sc in next sc, \*sc in next 17 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from \* to last 4 sc, sc in last 4 sc; join with sl st in first sc – 114 sc.

Rnd 20: Ch 1, turn, sc in next 9 sc, 2 sc in next sc, \*sc in next 18 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from \* to last 9 sc, sc in last 9 sc; join with sl st in first sc – 120 sc.

Rnd 21: Ch 1, turn, \*sc in next 19 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from \* around; join with sl st in first sc – 126 sc.

Rnd 22: Ch 1, turn, sc in next 6 sc, 2 sc in next sc, \*sc in next 20 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from \* to last 14 sc, sc in last 14 sc; join with sl st in first sc – 132 sc.

Rnd 23: Ch 1, turn, sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc, \*sc in next 21 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from \* to last 17 sc, sc in last 17 sc; join with sl st in first sc – 138 sc.

Rnd 24: Ch 1, turn, sc in next 9 sc, 2 sc in next sc, \*sc in next 22 sc, 2 sc in next sc; rep from \* to last 13 sc, sc in last 13 sc; join with sl st in first sc – 144 sc.

Rnd 25: Ch 1, turn, \*sl st in next st, ch 1; rep from \* around; join with sl st in first sl st. Fasten off.

#### **FINISHING**

Weave in ends.
