

A Guide to Using the Post-9/11 GI Bill

WHAT IS THE POST-9/11 GI BILL?

U.S. ARMY

Qualifying active duty, veterans and military spouses and dependents are eligible to receive reimbursement from the Department of Veterans Affairs for fees associated with the ACE Personal Trainer, Health Coach, Group Fitness Instructor and Medical Exercise Specialist Certification exams.

AMIELIGIBLE?

The Post-9/11 GI Bill provides financial support for education and housing to individuals with at least 90 days of aggregate active duty service after Sept. 10, 2001 and are still on active duty, or individuals discharged with a service-connected disability after 30 days. HOW CAN I APPLY FOR REIMBURSEMENT?



Step 1 Earn your ACE Certification by passing the ACE exam.



Step 2 Confirm your eligibility to receive VA education benefits on the VA's Education Benefits Eligibility website.



Step 3

Fill out VA Form 22-0803 to apply for reimbursement.
