Conditions of Enrolment

- It is the responsibility of students to ensure that they attend all scheduled lessons.
- Fees are charged at the above rate for up to eight lessons per term and are added to the school fee account.
- Fees are not refundable.
- Students can not cease lessons during a term.
- Written notice must be given one week before the end of a term if lessons are not continuing.
- A Music Levy of \$80 per year per student is charged. This applies to students in Years 6 to 12.
- Students having lessons at school are required to participate in a school ensemble if a position is available.
- School fee accounts must be current for a student to participate in the instrumental music program.
- Lessons will only be rescheduled, at the discretion of the tutor, if sufficient prior notice (at least 48 hours), has been received by the Music Department explaining the absence.
- In the case of school absence please inform the Music Department via email music@slc.qld.edu.au and the tutor directly that your son will not attend his music lesson.
