#### **Bulldog Bones**

- Fresno State enters this week in a three-way tie atop the conference standings with New Mexico (3-1) and Colorado State (6-2). With the Rams' win in Boise on Wednesday afternoon, they hold a half-game lead over the Bulldogs.
- The Bulldogs are currently riding a five-game conference win streak following a two-game sweep of Boise State, their first since over the Broncos since 2014.
- While the Fresno State and New Mexico are level on percentage points, the 'Dogs have played twice as many league games and six more games overall.
- The series marks a clash between two of the league's top scoring offenses with UNM at 88.3 points per game and Fresno State at 79.4. The Bulldogs holding the edge in conference games, 77.4-76.8.
- Fresno State's offense ranks 25th nationally in scoring offense, third highest in the Mountain
- The Bulldogs rank 19th nationally in turnovers per game with 12.5 per contest.
- Haley Cavinder (19.6 ppg) and Hanna Cavinder (17.5 ppg) sit 1-2 in the league in scoring. They rank among the nation's top 20 scoring duos (37.1 ppg).
- With one of the two leading the Bulldogs in scoring in all 11 games, Fresno State is 5-2 this season when the duo scores at least 38 points.
- Maddi Utti and the Cavinders have averaged a combined 52.0 points per game when together in the starting lineup this season. They have twice combined for a season-high 65 points since the start of 2021.

Fresno State and New Mexico have combined score under 70 points five times this season with a record of 1-4. 90

The Bulldogs and Lobos have combined score 90 or more points in a game seven times with a 6-1 record.



Fresno State has lost one game this season when shooting above 44 percent.

#### **Back-to-back sweeps**

After earning their first sweep of the conference season against Nevada, the Bulldogs built on that momentum with a sweep of Boise State, their first two-game regular-season sweep of the Broncos since 2014. The two wins in three days snapped Boise State's streak of 41 series with at least earn a split.

- Game 1 saw the 'Dogs post their fourth 90-point game of the season, defeat BSU 92-57. The 35-point differential was the largest margin of victory ever for Fresno State in Mountain West contest.
- Game 2 was a different story as the Bulldogs and Broncos traded runs until the final minutes of the game. The 'Dogs got 38 of their 67 points from Maddi Utti and (20) and Haley Cavinder (18). Cavinder scored or assisted on six of the team's final nine points.

#### **Running on premium**

Averaging 79.4 points per game thus far, the Bulldogs' offense is scoring 3.3 points better than a year ago when they posted a second-highest season in program history (76.1), and 1.0 ahead of the program's season record.

- Entering this season, Jaime White's teams have recorded at least 90 points in a game six times with three of those coming in 2019-20. This year, the 'Dogs reached 90 points three times during their first six games.
- Fresno State ranks 30th nationally in scoring offense (79.4) is shooting at a 45.1 percent clip which ranks 43rd in the NCAA.

#### Calm under pressure

With all three of its primary ballhandlers back, Fresno State's offensive engine is expected to stay in high gear. Last year the Bulldogs' broke program records for least turnovers per game with 12.1 (13.7 - 2017-18) and assist/turnover ratio of 1.30 (1.11 - 2011-12). Fresno State finished last year ranked No. 12 in the nation in assist/turnover ratio and No. 16 in turnovers per game.

- Fresno State currently ranks 19th nationally in turnovers per game (12.5).

#### **Twin scoring 'Dogs**

Averaging a combined 37.1 points per game, Haley Cavinder and Hanna Cavinder rank among the nation's best scoring duos. Throughout the first half of the of the season, the Bulldogs have been led in the scoring column by Haley (19.6 ppg) and Hanna (17.5 ppg) who rank first and second in the MW. The two have combined to score at least 38 points in seven games, helping the 'Dogs to a 5-2 record in those contests.

- The two rank among the top 20 nationally among the top scoring duos.
- The two have combined to go for 40-plus on six occasions, and are 4-2 in such games.
- Fresno State is 3-3 when the duo scores below 35 points.

#### Another "of the Week" honor

On Dec. 7, Haley Cavinder earned Fresno State's first Mountain West Player of the Week honor after averaging 21.5 points, 10.5 rebounds, 3.5 assists and 1.5 steals per game during the Bulldogs' conference opening series against Colorado State. That was just the start as the sophomore is the current back-to-back Player of the Week after two huge weeks during the Bulldogs' sweeps of Nevada and Boise State.

- Despite being named the 2019-20 MW Freshman of the Year, Cavinder did not claim a weekly honor during her first season.
- Fresno State won five of the conference's weekly honors last year with Hanna Cavinder and Maddi Utti twice and Aly Gamez once. Haley Cavinder has claimed both of Fresno State's during the 2020-21 season.
- On Jan. 20, she was named to the NCAA Team of the Week for Week 8.





#### Rising to another level

As a freshman, Haley Cavinder led the Bulldogs in scoring at 16.0 points per game. She is doing the same again but has increased that avaerage to a league-leading 20.2 points per game. Without a 20-point outing during the opening weekend of the season, Cavinder has five in the last seven games, which includes a 30-point outing on Jan. 14.

- Cavinder is averaging 21.1 points per game in conference play, 4.0 points clear of the secondhighest average.
- Cavinder is also leading the team in assists (3.7 apg) and rebounding (7.7 rpg).

#### Finding focus

A year after shooting just 68.1 percent from the free throw line, Haley Cavinder has not only been getting to the line at higher rate but the sophomore also has increased her percentage by nearly 20 percent, shooting 86.9 percent.

- Cavinder leads the league in free throws made free throws with 53.
- Cavinder has taken 61 attempts this season, 4.7 attempts per game compared to 2.25 attempts per game last year.
- On Jan. 14 vs. Nevada, she converted a career-high 11-of-12 at the line.

#### **Getting into a groove**

After missing the first two games of her career in mid-December, senior Maddi Utti has in recent weeks looked more and more like the player who was tabbed to multiple preseason national watch lists. The 5-foot-11 foward has notched three straight double-doubles, averaging 17.7 points and 11.0 rebounds in those contests.

#### She can shoot from 3?!

Known for her prowess and proficiency around the paint, Maddi Utti has been working on her outside shot throughout the past two offseasons. During her first two seasons at Fresno State, Utti attempted just seven 3-pointers, making three. She increased her attempts to 48 last year with 12 makes. In 10 games this season, the senior has taken 24, knocking down 11 of those.

- Eight of Utti's made 3's have come within the last five games (8-of-13).

#### Not overlooking her now

Being a tweener can you get you overlooked. Playing at a small school can also get you overlooked. One's heart should not be overlooked. One of the best players to put on a Fresno State jersey, Maddi Utti has proved in three seasons that she was overlooked. The undersized 5-foot-11 forward has proved it through sheer determination and impressive athleticism.

Efficiency has been the key for Utti. No wasted movements. For her career, Utti entered the 2020-21 season second in program history in field goal percentage (.539), fifth in rebounds per game (7.34), ninth in steals per game (1.9) and 16th in points (1,200). She had started 90 consecutive games while playing in 96.

#### In elite company

In November, reigning Mountain West Player of the Year, Maddi Utti was one of 50 players named to the Naismith Trophy watch list, was one of 20 players selected to the Katrina McClain Award watch list, and was one of 25 players tabbed to the Becky Hammon Mid-Major Player of the Year watch list.

- Utti was one of 10 players on the Naismith Trophy watch list from a non-P5 school, and one of six of those 10 players not from UConn.
- Last year, Utti was one of five players in the nation to average at least 15 points, eight rebounds and two steals. She finished the season with 509 points, 284 rebounds and 73 steals.

#### The trio

Like they did a year ago, the trio of Haley Cavinder, Hanna Cavinder and Maddi Utti have been 1, 2, 3 in the scoring column for much of the year, accounting for 52.0 points per game together. The trio has scored twice scoring a season-high 65 points (at Wyoming-G2, Nevada-G1).

- A year ago, they were one of only two trios in the country to have all three players average at least 15 points per game. The other trio was Oregon's Sabrina Ionescu, Satou Sabally and Ruthy Hebard who went No. 1, 2 and 8 respectively in the 2020 WNBA Draft.
- Fresno State was the only team in the nation to have three players score 500 points (Haley Cavinder 512, Maddi Utti 509, Hanna Cavinder 502).
- Utti missed Game 5 and 6 of the season.

#### It's actually a big four

When Aly Gamez joins the double-digit party with the trio, the Bulldogs' win probably has gone up dramatically. Fresno State has lost just one when game during the last two seasons when all four players have been in double figures.

- The 'Dogs are 12-1 since the start of the 2019-20 season when Gamez, Utti and the Cavinder twins each score at least 10 points.
- Gamez is one of four Bulldogs to average double figures this season at 10.0 points per game.

#### Attack mode engaged

One of six returning All-Mountain West players from a season ago, Hanna Cavinder was the odd one out on this year's five-member preseason team and she has been in attack mode since the start of the season to prove that it was a mistake. The sophomore sits second in the MW in scoring (17.5 ppg).

- Cavinder has led the team in scoring in seven of its 13 games.

### Putting it all together

With high expectations after a solid freshman season as a reserve, Brooke Walling had struggled during the first moth of the season. With players in the frontcourt unavailable after the New Year in Wyoming, Walling had the best two-game stretch of her young career, scoring 20 points, 11 rebounds, six blocks and two steals while playing 76 of 85 minutes.

- Walling had a career-best 13 points on 6-of-9 shooting in the Bulldogs' 83-80 win.

#### Motta's motor running high

Like a season ago, Wytalla Motta once again was slow getting out of the gates but her production recently has increased. Prior to the holiday break, the senior from Brazil posted her first-career double-double (10 points/13 rebounds). Unavailable for the Wyoming series, she came back strong against CSU Bakersfield with a career-best 13 points on 6-of-10 shooting.

- Motta also recorded her first two steals of the season against the Roadrunners.
- The following week, the senior collected four steals and had two blocks in the Bulldogs' two-game series against Nevada.





#### Always looming

When Kendyll Kinzer is on the floor, everyone needs to be aware. Whether it's finding space in a half-court offense, leaking out in transition or trailing a ball handler, the 6-foot-1 forward from Idaho has been a knock down 3-pointer for the Bulldogs. After missing her first six shots this season during the opening weekend of play, Kinzer 48.4 percent (15-of-31) from behind the arc since.

- Kinzer has knocked down 56.0 percent of her attempts during her last seven games (14-of-25), and 55.6 percent since the start of the New Year (9-of-15).

#### New face from Georgia

How'd the 'Dogs get a player to come all the across the country? A former player turned coach. LaToya Brown, who played at Fresno State for two seasons from 2008-2009, helped the Bulldogs land one of their latest players. Keely Brown was a star at Luella High School under the former Bulldog's tutelage. Choosing to follow in her coach's footsteps, Keely has quickly started to produce for the Bulldogs.

- Brown scored a season-high 12 points on 5-of-6 shooting against Saint Mary's.

#### **Breaking out**

Entering the Bulldogs' contest at San Francisco (Dec. 13), Yanina Todorova had played 40 minutes and totaled 17 points, one rebound and one assist. With the 'Dogs needing a spark, JC transfer provided it, scoring 20 points on 6-of-10 shooting, 4-of-6 from 3, and grabbing six boards and dishing out three assists in 32 minutes.

#### Doubling up

In Fresno State's first conference win of the season, Haley Cavinder and Aly Gamez played bigger than their 5-foot-6 and 5-foot-5 statures as both posted double-doubles with points and rebounds. Cavinder had 19 points and 13 rebounds while Gamez had 10 points and 10 rebounds. Gamez earned here 10th rebound on the last defensive rebound of the game and her ninth and 10th points iced the game at the free throw line.

- It was only the third time in the last 10 years that two Bulldog guards have recorded double-doubles in the same game.
- Gamez and Candice White in 2018 were the only other Fresno state guard duo to do it under Jaime White.

#### Joining the club

Heading into the first game of the season, Aly Gamez was seven points shy of a 1,000 for her career. On her final point of the game, she reached that seventh point.

- Gamez is the 26th player in Fresno State's history to score 1,000 points in a career.
- The senior is the fifth player to join the illustrious club under Head Coach Jaime White (Alex Sheedy 2014, Bego Faz Davalos 2016, Candice White 2018, Maddi Utti 2020).

#### One of California's Best

- Heading into the 2020-10 season, the Fresno State women's basketball team remains one of the top Division I programs in the state of California during the last 11 seasons.
- The Bulldogs have amassed 250 wins, which ranks third out of the 25 schools in California.
- Fresno State is one of three schools to own at least 250 wins, with the other two being from the Pac-12.
- During the last 11 years, Fresno State (250) has more victories than Pac-12 schools like California (233), and USC (196).
- The Bulldogs' win total is only behind Stanford's 310 and UCLA's 251 among California schools.

#### **SCOUTING NEW MEXICO**

- New Mexico is coming off its second weekend off during the past three weeks.
- The Lobos sit at 6-1 on the year and is in a three-way tie atop the league based on percentage points with Colorado State and Fresno State.
- UNM ranks fourth nationally in scoring offense at 88.3 points per game. While the Lobos have eclipsed 80 points in two its four conference games, their highest scoring games came in the nonconference to Arkansas-Pine Bluff (120), Sam Houston State (98) and Midwestern State (93).
- All five of New Mexico's starters averages double digits, led by Jaedyn De La Cerda at 16.9 points per game. Twin newcomers LaTascya and LaTora Duff sit second and third at 14.7 ppg and 12.7 ppg, respectively.
- Like the Bulldogs, the Lobos' high-octane offense allows for scoring at the other end, allowing  $72.4~\rm ppg,\,0.4$  less than the 'Dogs.

## **Jaime White**

Head Coach Seventh Season at Fresno State (Southern Utah '94)

Jaime White enters her seventh season as the head coach of the Fresno State women's basketball program. In her six seasons with the Bulldogs, White has guided the 'Dogs to three 20-win seasons, four postseason appearances and three appearances in the Mountain West tournament championship game. Among active coaches in the Mountain West, White holds the highest winning percentage in overall (.633, 124-72) and in league games (.685, 74-34).

White's sixth season in Fresno was a banner year as she guided the Bulldogs to a 25-7 record on the program's first MW regular season championship with a 16-2 record, and only third outright regular season conference title. The 'Dogs also reached their third MW championship game in five seasons. White's team won its first 15 games of league play, the second-longest win streak to open a season for Fresno State. The Bulldogs also won 14 consecutive games from Dec. 28-Feb. 15, a streak that is also second in the program's history. The wins added up as Fresno State averaged its highest scoring average (76.1 ppg) in more than 30 years and posted its second-best free-throw percentage (76.2%) behind only last season's school record. Limiting turnovers was key to the team's offense, breaking program records for assist-to-turnover ratio (1.30) and turnovers per game (72.1).

The Bulldogs racked up their most postseason honors in a season (9) as White was named Coach of the Year, Maddi Utti was selected Player of the Year and Haley Cavinder was tabbed Freshman of the Year. It was just the second time in conference history that a team claimed all three awards in the same season.

Led by Candice White in 2018-19, the senior paced the MW in scoring for the second season in a row with 18.4 points per game, the Bulldogs earned their third trip to the WNIT under White. The 'Dogs finished the year with a 19-13 record after placing fourth in the MW while reaching the semifinals of the conference tournament for the sixth time in their seven seasons in the league. Fresno State averaged 69.7 points per game, the highest during White's tenure. The Bulldogs' scoring was aided by the team shooting a program-record 78.4 percent from the free-throw line.

While Candice White earned her second All-MW selection in her final season, Maddi Utti garnered a honorable mention nod. The sophomore was also selected to the MW All-Defensive Team after being the only player in the league to rank in the top 10 in rebounds, blocks and steals.

With her youngest roster to date, White navigated the 2017-18 season by starting three true freshmen in 24 games, the most of any Division I team during a year in which they finished 17-15. Fresno State finished fourth in the league (11-7) to earn a first-round bye in the tournament for the fifth time in its six years in the conference. The 'Dogs returned to the postseason with a bid to the Women's Basketball Invitational where they captured the program's first postseason win in a true road game at CSU Bakersfield, 77-66.

Junior Candice White led the young group of Bulldogs as she garnered All-MW honors after leading the team in points, rebounds, assists and

She became just the second Fresno State player to score more than 600 points in season (605). Joining the junior with postseason accolades were freshmen Aly Gamez and Maddi Utti who were both named to the MW All-Freshman Team after being instant impact players for the Bulldogs as each ranked second or third on the team in points, rebounds, assists and steals

Through an up-and-down 2016-17 season in which the 'Dogs finished 18-15, White's team came together late in the season to propel it to a run of three wins in three days at the MW Tournament to reach its second-straight championship game. Along the way, the Bulldogs became the first No. 7 seed to defeat a No. 2 seed, and the lowest seed to reach the championship game in tournament history.

The Bulldogs were led by two-time MW Defensive Player of the Year, Bego Faz Davalos, and a breakout season from sophomore guard Candice White who earned All-MW honorable mention honors. Faz Davalos ranked in the top 10 in the NCAA in seven stat categories while breaking multiple season and career records at Fresno State and in the Mountain West. White ranked 15th in the NCAA in free-throw percentage and 37th in 3-point percentage. The sophomore's 87.7 percent from the free-throw line set the Fresno State single-season record while also moving into the top 10 in points in a season, 3's made in a season and career 3-point percentage.

White's 2016 squad went 22-12 overall and reached the second round of the WNIT with a 59-53 win over Santa Clara. It was the second consecutive season with a postseason victory for the Bulldogs, a first in the program's history.

A year after turning Fresno State into one of the top defensive teams in the Mountain West, White's defensive brand of basketball set a program low for opponent field-goal percentage (.371) and allowed 59.4 points per game, the team's lowest since 2006 and the third lowest in program history. A big piece to that was the shot blocking of Bego Faz Davalos who was named MW Defensive Player of the Year after leading the NCAA with 136 blocked shots.

Faz Davalos also garnered postseason All-MW honors along with Toni Smith who earned honorable mention accolades and Breanne Knishka who was selected to the MW All-Freshmen Team.

In her first season, White guided the 'Dogs to their seventh consecutive season of 20 or more wins (23) and to the postseason for the eighth consecutive year, reaching the second round of the Women's National Invitational Tournament. The team's 79-73 win over San Francisco at the Save Mart Center in the first round of the WNIT was the program's first postseason win since 2006.

During the middle of the season, White's group recorded the second-longest win streak in Fresno State's history at 13 games, an unbeaten stretch that lasted nearly two months. The final win of that streak gave the 'Dogs a 17-3 record to open the season, a mark that ranks as the best 20-game start in school history.

It took White little time to put her stamp on the Bulldogs' defense as her squad was the only team in the conference to finish in the top two in the Mountain West in scoring defense, field goal percentage defense, 3-point percentage defense, blocks and steals during the conference season. The 'Dogs led the MW in scoring defense (55.8 ppg), 3-point defense (.259), block shots (5.7 bpg) and steals (12.3 spg).

Under White's tutelage, a trio of Bulldogs garnered a total of five postseason conference honors, with Alex Sheedy highlighting the group after being named Co-Player of the Year. Sheedy was subsequently also selected to the All-MW team. Fellow senior Raven Fox earned Sixth Player of the Year and was named to the All-Defensive Team. After breaking three conference records for blocked shots, Bego Faz Davalos earned a spot on the All-Freshman Team.
