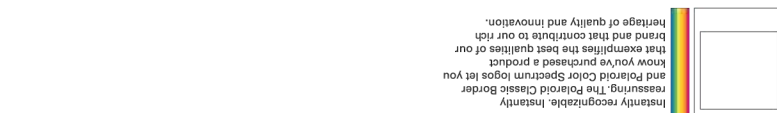

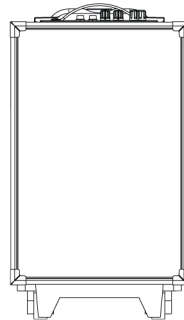

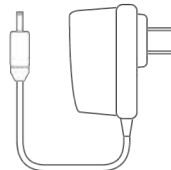
- Reorient or relocate the receiving antenna.

- Consult the dealer or an experienced radio/TV technician for help.



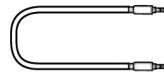

### USING THE SPEAKER

#### Power ON and OFF

- Turn the speaker on by sliding the [ON/OFF] switch to the ON position.
- Turn the speaker off by sliding the [ON/OFF] switch to the OFF position.

#### Adjusting the Volume

Adjust the volume by turning the Master volume control knob.

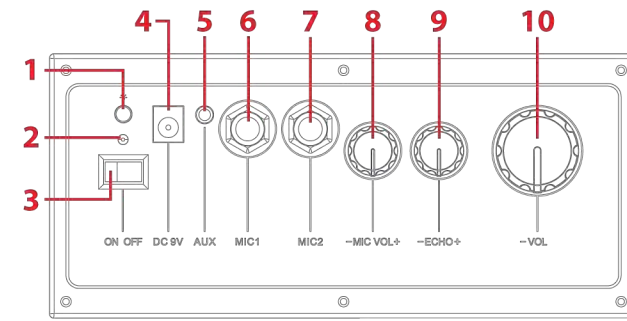
- Turn the master volume control knob to the left to increase the volume.
- Turn the master volume control knob to the right to decrease the volume.

#### Playing Music

To enjoy music wirelessly on your speaker, make sure that the speaker is properly paired to your Bluetooth-enabled device. If you are pairing the speaker for the first time, go to the "Pairing the Speaker" section of this user manual.

Use the controls on your Bluetooth-paired device to play and pause music or to skip tracks.

### LOCATION OF CONTROLS



(Top - Control Panel)

1. [ ] Button
2. LED Indicator
3. [POWER] Switch
4. DC 9V Power Jack
5. AUX-In Jack
6. Microphone 1 Input Jack
7. Microphone 2 Input Jack
8. Microphone Vol Knob
9. Microphone Echo Knob
10. Volume Knob

### USING THE SPEAKER (cont'd)

**NOTE:** Microphone not included.

#### Using the Mic Inputs

To use a microphone, plug the 1/8" connector of the wired microphone cable into either the MIC 1 or MIC 2 input jacks.

**NOTE:** Music will continue to play while using the microphones.

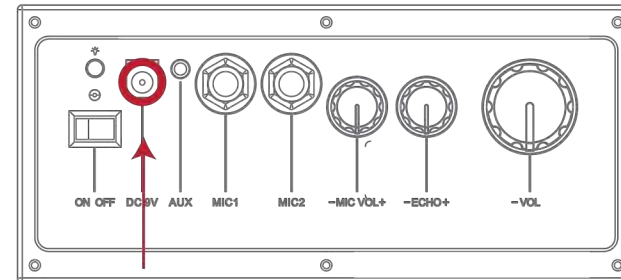
#### Adjusting Mic Volume

- Turn the Mic Volume knob to the left to decrease microphone volume and turn to the right to increase microphone volume.

#### Adjusting Mic Echo

- Turn the Mic Echo knob to the left to decrease microphone echo and turn to the right to increase microphone echo.

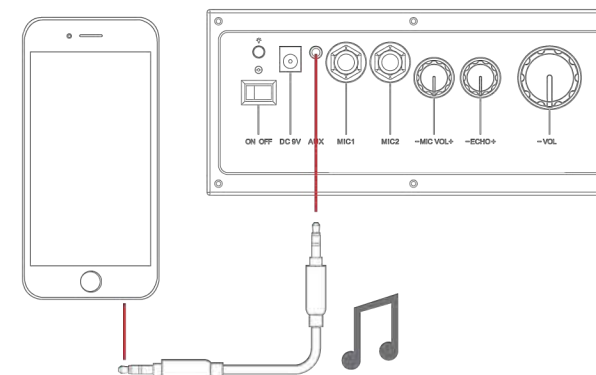
### CHARGING THE SPEAKER



To charge the speaker, attach the charging adaptor to the DC 9V power jack. Plug the adaptor into a working wall outlet. The LED indicator will turn solid RED while charging and turn off when finished.

### USING AS A WIRED SPEAKER

To use the speaker as a wired device, attach the 3.5mm AUX cable to the AUX-in jack and attach the other end to the headphone jack on your media-playing device.

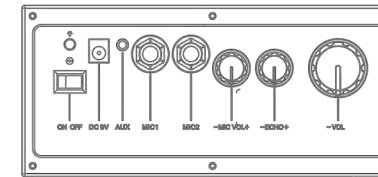
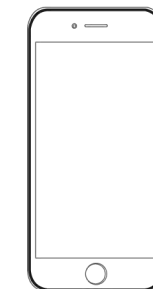


Connecting the audio cable will override Bluetooth mode if it is enabled. When the cable is disconnected, the speaker will automatically reconnect to the last paired device if Bluetooth mode is enabled.

### PAIRING THE SPEAKER

1. Slide the [POWER] switch to the ON position. A tone will be heard, indicating that the speaker is pairing mode. The LED indicator will quickly flash BLUE.

2. Open the Bluetooth settings menu on your mobile device. Set your device to search for other Bluetooth-enabled devices nearby (for detailed instructions for pairing your Bluetooth-enabled device, consult your device's user documentation).



### PAIRING THE SPEAKER (cont'd)

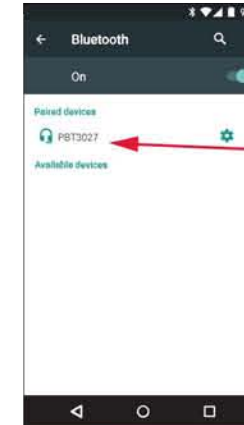
3. Locate the speaker's model number (**PBT3027**) from the list of discovered devices and press it to complete the pairing process.

**NOTE:** If prompted for a password, enter **0000** (four zeros). This step may be necessary for older Bluetooth-enabled mobile devices.



### PAIRING THE SPEAKER (cont'd)

4. Another tone is heard, indicating that your mobile device has successfully paired with the speaker. The LED indicator will slowly flash BLUE.



Found devices



The screenshots above are typical of many Bluetooth-enabled devices in the market today, and are used to assist in the explanation of the pairing process. Your Bluetooth-enabled device's interface and interaction with the speaker may differ slightly from the illustrations shown.

### TROUBLESHOOTING

I can pair the speaker with my Bluetooth device, but I cannot hear any music.

1. Make sure your Bluetooth device supports A2DP profile.
2. Turn up the volume on your Bluetooth device.
3. You may have to unpair the speaker, then re-pair to your device.

My Bluetooth device is not able to pair with the speaker.

1. Make sure the speaker is turned ON before beginning the pairing process.
2. Keep the speaker and Bluetooth-enabled device within 3 feet of each other during the pairing process.
3. Check that YOUR device's Bluetooth feature is turned ON.
4. Try repeating the pairing process; see "Pairing the Speaker."
5. Make sure the speaker is charged.

I cannot get the speaker into pairing mode.

1. Make sure the speaker is turned ON before beginning the pairing process.
2. Keep the speaker and your mobile device within 3 feet of each other during the pairing process.
3. Check that the speaker is charged.

### WARRANTY

This product as supplied and distributed new by AIT, Inc. ("AIT") to the original consumer purchaser is warranted by AIT against defects in material and workmanship for a period of one year from your date of purchase ("Warranty").
