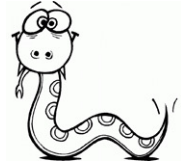

Storm Drain: The gutter in the street outside your home carries water into a network of storm drains that lead to our local water ways. Storm drains are separate from the sanitary sewer system, which handles wastewater from our sinks, tubs and toilets. Unlike wastewater, storm water is not treated at a sewage treatment plant. Storm water goes directly from storm drainage system into our local water ways. Please be careful what goes into your storm drain.
