# 1. General

## **1.1. Introduction**

Mosaic is a suite of collaboration products designed to simplify how people share content and collaborate with each other. This document gives a high-level overview of Mosaic Canvas, a digital whiteboard tool, and Mosaic Connect, a wireless presentation solution. Both tools are included as standard on NEC's CB series display.

## **1.2. System Requirements**

To run Mosaic Connect and Canvas, we recommend the following specification:

# 1.3. Installation and activation

Both Canvas and Connect are pre-installed on the CB series display. There is no requirement to activate the software. To launch either application, tap the icon on the CB series home screen.



## **Getting the Mosaic Connect App**

Mosaic client app is available through Android and iOS app stores.

The easiest way to get the correct version is by visiting <u>https://connectmosaic.com</u> on the device. The browser will automatically detect your device and provide a link to download the app.




# 2. Mosaic Connect

## 2.1. Mosaic Connect home screen

The home screen contains the following information:

- Joining instructions and Web URL for attendees
- Session ID
- PIN (optional)
- Overview of connected attendees
- Settings
- New session
- Exit Mosaic Connect
- Shared items
- Home button



## 2.2. Creating a session

Please make sure the system is connected to the internet to make the app online.

When the user first launches Mosaic Connect, a session ID will be generated. The user can also create a new session from Mosaic Connect by clicking or tapping on 'new session', at the bottom of the screen.



If it's the user's first time using Mosaic Connect, they need to visit <u>www.connectmosaic.com</u> where they'll find instructions on how to join a session.


Please note, this page will adapt to attendee's hardware. i.e. Windows users will get Windows software and Mac users will get Mac software.

Users can choose to join via the web (Chrome and Firefox).

Once the receiver setting is done and Mosaic Connect app is online and running, attendees can connect to the session using client application on their respective devices, and up to 4 connections are allowed. From any client (Windows/Guest/Android/Web) open the connect application.


### 2.3.1 Joining via native application

Once a user has downloaded and opened the native application, the following screen is displayed:



To join, the user should enter the session ID (shown on the display), their name and then press Connect. If a PIN is required, this is an additional step. Once a user connects, their name will be shown on the home screen.





#### 2.3.2. Joining via AirPlay

To join via airplay, swipe up on your Apple device and select "screen mirroring".




To start presenting, select the name of the display you would like to present to - you can find this on the top right-hand corner of the home screen. You will be prompted to enter a password: the password is the same as the session ID.

Once connected, your name will appear on the list of connected attendees on the right-hand side. Finally, double tap your name on the touch display to present your screen.




### 2.3.3. Joining via web

To connect via web, go to <u>www.connectmosaic.com</u> and choose the option `connect via web'. <u>Note</u>: Web application should be used via Google Chrome or Firefox.



Enter your name, session ID and PIN if required.

Choose to present either your entire screen or specific application window and then click share.





## 2.4. Client Toolbars

Once you're connected to the session, you can use the Mosaic Connect toolbar to:

- Share/stop sharing your screen •
- Pause sharing

### 2.5. System Organization & Navigation


Once the receiver is online and running, a screen with Session ID (6 or 10 digit) with or without PIN (depends on the setting) is displayed. The CBxx1Q name is displayed on the upper right hand corner. This name can be changed in the settings - e.g. to "Meeting Room 1", as shown in the example below. A list of all attendees is displayed on the home screen. The Language, Display, Audio, Network & Connections, and Security all these options are available in the settings.

### 2.5.1. Sharing a screen

Attendees can share their screen with "Become a presenter" option. For windows client presenter, the control can be taken from main display. For Mac presenter, the control from main display is not possible. The screen can also be shared from mobile and Web application.



 $\underline{\text{NOTE}}$ : When presenting through iOS, there is an additional step which is required to "Start Broadcast".



#### 2.5.2. **Sharing items**

Client and Receiver has the "Shared items" option, using which different files, links and videos can be shared with attendees. All shared items are kept under this option which can be easily accessed and ready for view or download for all attendees. Different web links can be shared as well as presented on the screen with all attendees.

File formats supported:

- Audio(.mp3, .wav)
- Document(.doc, .docx, .xls, .xlsx, .ppt, .pptm, .pptx, .txt, .odt, .ods, .odp) •
- Image (.jpg, .png)
- PDF (.pdf)
- Zip (.zip)




Note: Once the session is closed, all shared documents will be no longer available.

#### 2.5.3. **In-built media player**

The application has in-built media player, media files can be played from the receiver or client and runs smoothly with great guality. The supported file formats are (.avi, .mov, .mp4). The web links can be shared from shared items and directly presented on the screen.










## 2.6. In-built media player

The session can be disconnected by choosing "Exit" option from the respective applications. The session can also be terminated in between the meeting. If receiver exits, all attendees will be thrown out of the session automatically.

#### 2.6.1 Error and recovery

Error message - "There's been a problem"



Recovery - After initial start up the internet configuration is required to be done via Admin user. Sign out from the default user and sign in into Admin user and connect to the internet which will make Mosaic Connect app online.

## 2.7. Managing attendees from the main display

Users of Mosaic Connect can use the home screen to invite an attendee to present. To do so, go to the home screen and double tap a user's name.

Before sharing their screen, each user will get a prompt asking them to confirm if they would like their screen to be wirelessly presented. If they select Yes, it will be shown on the main display. If they select No, Mosaic Connect will remain at the home screen.

Mosaic Connect enables back control of any connecting Windows PC.

Settings are accessible via the Mosaic Connect home screen. Settings are arranged as following:



#### 2.8.2. Audio

The user can select which speakers to use during their Connect session. Users can change video or audio outputs during a session, without disrupting the flow of the session.

Users can choose to allow local connections only (i.e. connect to sessions while on the same network). They can enable or disable a PIN.



The Mosaic Canvas toolbar contains the following tools and subsets:



# 3.3. Saving/downloading a board

Each board can be downloaded to the local device. User can choose to download a Current board (the board they are working on) or All boards (every board in that session).

## 3.5. Renaming, duplicating and deleting a board

To rename, duplicate or delete a board, tap the three dots in the top left-hand corner of your board.
