2012 ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES AND APPLICATION DEADLINE: August 31, 2012

Scholarship Amount: Two scholarships of \$5,000 each will be awarded to qualified students with an intended major in Engineering.

Scholarship Application Requirements:

- Demonstrated success in STEM education courses (Science, Technology, Engineering and Math)
- An intended Major in Engineering
- Demonstrated community involvement over a period of several years
- Current graduating senior residing in Somerset, Hunterdon or Morris Counties, New Jersey
- United States citizen or Legal Resident
- Minimum cumulative high school grade point average of 3.5
- Intention to enroll fulltime in university or college

To apply for Juniper Networks scholarships complete the application form and submit along with the following documents:

- Personal Statement / Essay
- Letters of Reference
- Academic Transcripts
- Financial Statements (SAR OR tax returns OR equivalent)

APPLICATION PROCESS:

1. Juniper's scholarship application process is limited to two scholarship awards of \$5,000 each to a deserving high school graduate with an intended major in Engineering.
2. Applicants must be current residents of Somerset, Hunterdon or Morris County, New Jersey.
3. Applications must be submitted per the below instructions and include the required attachments. Incomplete applications will not be reviewed.
4. Juniper will take financial need into consideration, but the primary focus will be on academic achievement, academic potential and/or community service.
5. The scholarship program is open only to graduated high school seniors.
6. Your personal statement / essay should address the first three bullets on page 1 under Scholarship Application Requirements and make a strong case for why you are the best candidate for the Juniper scholarship. Juniper will not consider or review applications that include a personal statement / essay in excess of three pages.
7. In an effort to decrease paper usage, **only electronic submissions will be reviewed and considered.**
8. **Submit one electronic copy, which must include all required documents,** to communityengagement@juniper.net with subject title "Juniper Scholarship."
9. Notification will be sent to the address provided. Should you be awarded the Juniper scholarship, your scholarship payments will be sent directly to college financial aid offices of your chosen university or college.
