What is the TSI Assessment?

Placement test used to determine college readiness:

- Writing, Reading, and Math
- Not a pass/fail test
- Untimed
- Computer adaptive
- Scored immediately

Do I have to take the TSI-A? YES

Exemptions:

- ACT
- pSAT
- SAT
- STAAR (EOC)

Note:

- *Handled by Registrar's Office
- *Valid for five (5) years from the date of testing
- *Only one exemption is accepted

Exemptions: ACT

ACT Requirements:

- Composite score of **23** and **19+** on the English and/or mathematics test sections

Exemptions: SAT

SAT Requirements:

PRIOR to March 2016

- A combined score of 1070 from critical reading and mathematics areas
- A minimum of 500 on math for an exemption in math and/or
- A minimum of 500 on critical reading for an exemption in writing and reading

Exemptions: SAT

SAT Requirements:

AFTER March 2016

- **There is no combined score, however;**
- A minimum of 530 on math for an exemption in math and/or
- A minimum of 480 on the Evidence-Based Reading and Writing for an exemption in writing and reading

Note: test scores prior to March 2016 and test scores after March 2016 cannot be combined.

Exemption: STAAR (EOC)

STAAR (EOC): Algebra II score of Level 2

- ▶ Reading English III EOC Level 2
- ▶ Writing English III EOC Level 2


Am I Required to Pay?

- Free testing for Tarrant County high school students.
- Seniors: last day to test for free- August 23, 2021.
- Retests are free for high school students and TCC-bound students.
- Testing for different institution: \$10/section.



Testing Services Agreement:

Tarrant County College Testing Services Rules Agreement COVID-19
Please carefully read the following directions and rules

The following items are prohibited while testing.

1. Personal calculators, cell phones, smart watches, Bluetooth headphones, and/or other electronic devices
2. Books, dictionaries, notes, written materials, reference materials, food/beverage, and/or any other unauthorized aids.

Prior to testing, you will initial & type your name on the agreement when corresponding with Testing Services indicating you understand the Testing Services Rules Agreement (TSRA). Please ask a member from your Testing Services Team if you have any questions regarding the TSRA.

_____ I MUST place my cell phone, smart watch, calculator, and/or any other small electronic device in another room. If I am found using any electronic device, my test session can be "invalidated".

_____ Breaks of any kind are not allowed while testing.

_____ (TSI-A Only) I MUST complete all sections of the test during my scheduled testing appointment with Examyti; I will not be able to save and finish the test in a later appointment.

_____ (TSI-A Only) I understand TCC will cover the cost of three (3) proctored test appointments with Examyti (Students planning to attend TCC only). If additional appointments are needed, I will be responsible for paying the \$20 proctor-fee per appointment with Examyti.

_____ I MUST show a valid and current picture ID to test and receive my scores.

_____ Hoodies or hats may NOT be worn while testing. Ball caps may be worn but MUST be turned around.

_____ I may NOT open any other software program or application, or navigate away from my exam for any reason.

_____ I MUST test in a distraction-free area alone for the duration of my test appointment.

_____ If applicable, Student Accessibility Resources Coordinator MUST approve any Testing Accommodations I may need before I can set a test appointment.

_____ Scratch paper and standard pen/pencil are allowed while I test. I will show both sides of my scratch paper to the proctor at the beginning and end of my test appointment.

_____ I will be monitored continuously during my appointment with a live proctor, and I will be video recorded.

_____ Proctors CANNOT answer questions related to exam content.

_____ If I need technical assistance while testing, I may ask the live proctor.

Candidate Statement:

I understand the information provided above and agree to follow these rules. If I do not follow these rules, or if I am suspected of misconduct and/or tampering with the computer or exam, the Proctor will report my actions, and this may result in ALL SECTIONS of the exam being invalidated (cancelled). The invalidation may not be reversed. Test invalidation will forfeit any fees I paid for my exam, and I will be required to pay the full exam fee (\$29) before I may retest.

COVID-19 Online Testing

- TSI Assessment administered through EXAMITY, live online third-party proctor.
- Internet service, device with webcam, speaker, and microphone; computer compatibility will be verified through Examity.
- Assessment is taken during Testing Appointments, scheduled with Examity, not TCC.
- Examity charges \$20 proctor fee. TCC covers the first three (3) attempts; the student is responsible for the 4th attempt and any thereafter.

The Birdville ISD Scholarship is a partnership between Birdville ISD and Tarrant County College.

The scholarship funds tuition costs up to:

- 15 in-county credit hours per semester
- Maximum of \$960 per semester

Scholarship available for two consecutive semesters.



Eligibility Requirements

- Student must be a BISD graduate who completed their junior and senior year at a BISD school.
- TCC must be the student's first college of attendance.
- Student must enroll at TCC and utilize the scholarship during the first fall or spring semester immediately following graduation (Fall 2021 or Spring 2022 semester).
- Scholarship will be forfeited if a student does not begin by the Spring 2022 semester.

BISD Scholarship & Other Financial Aid

- The BISD Scholarship is for students who do not qualify for other financial aid.
- If you receive financial aid that exceeds \$960 a semester (amount BISD covers) or the Stars of Tomorrow Scholarship, you will not be eligible to receive the BISD Scholarship.
- If you receive financial aid less than \$960 per semester and part of your tuition costs are unmet, the BISD Scholarship will pay the difference. If so, please notify the TCC Foundation.
- You may receive other scholarships to pay for expenses outside of tuition.

Financial Aid Process

- Complete the 2021-2022 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) application at www.fafsa.ed.gov.
- Enter TCC's school code: 003626 so TCC receives your FAFSA record.
- Check your Self-Service Financial Aid portal (accessible via your WebAdvisor account) by July 1st to confirm TCC has received your FAFSA.
- For undocumented students, the Texas Application for State Financial Aid (TASFA) forms can be found on the TCC Student Financial Aid Services Web Site:

Financial Aid Process (continued)

- Department of Education randomly selects students for a process called “verification”. If selected, student must provide additional information to Student Financial Aid Services. Check your myTCC email or Self-Service to find out what is needed.
- FAFSA must be received and verification process complete (if applicable) by August 23, 2021, in order to qualify for scholarship.

High School Transcript

- Submit a final official high school transcript (with high school graduation date listed) to TCC Registrar's office by August 23, 2021. You can request it via Parchment. Check with your high school counselor for more information.
- Dual credit students are prevented from being awarded until after graduation is confirmed. Follow the steps below:
 - Submit high school transcript
 - Select a degree plan
 - Notify Student Financial Aid Services. They will verify graduation and award.

Registration Requirements & Payments

- Student must register for a minimum of 6 credit hours.
- Tuition payment is not required if the BISD scholarship has been awarded. It will be listed as “Birdville ISD Tuition Scholarship” on the “My Awards” page of Self-Service.
- Prior to the 1st payment deadline, please confirm the BISD scholarship has been awarded or payment arrangements must be made via Business Services.
- Once BISD is awarded, the earliest tuition will be paid is 10 days before Fall classes begin. Tuition is paid on a weekly basis after this.

Troubleshooting

Common reasons the BISD scholarship has not been awarded:

- Social not on student's record
- FAFSA not completed, rejected or selected for verification
- Dual credit student who has not confirmed graduation with Student Financial Aid Services
- Student is awarded other financial aid

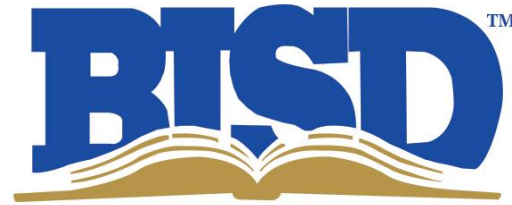
If you have completed all steps and do not see the BISD award on your Self-Service account, please contact the TCC Foundation.

Renewal Requirements

The BISD Scholarship is renewable for a 2nd semester if all requirements are met:

- Achieve a minimum semester GPA of 2.5
- Complete a minimum of 6 semester hours
- If Spring 2022 is student's 1st semester, the 2022-2023 FAFSA must be completed by the 1st day of TCC classes for Fall 2022. Fall begins a new academic year and eligibility must be verified again.
- After the semester has started, please contact the TCC Foundation BEFORE any classes are dropped.
