
Installing the SIM card, memory card and battery

ATTENTION:

- Risk of swallowing small objects! The SIM card & memory card can be removed. Small children can swallow them.
- Do not bend or scratch the SIM card. Prevent any contact with water, dirt or electrical charges.
- Turn off the phone and disconnect the charger before removing the battery cover.


- Remove the battery cover:

Remove it with the help of your nail or a small flat tool, following the




- Insert the Nano SIM card (mandatory) and the microSD memory card (optional, not supplied):

- 1) Slide the small metal part to the right side to unlock it.
- 2) With the finger nail, lift it up to the right side.
- 3) Place the SIM card in the SIM card holder with the golden contacts facing down and the cut corner at the lower left (drawing A). 4) Close the SIM card metal part and lock it by sliding to the left




*To expand the internal storage memory, you can insert a microSD memory card (maximum capacity of 32 GB / not included).

- Insert the battery:



Insert the battery into battery compartment with golden contacts of the battery facing downwards to the right of the phone. Press lightly on the top end of the pattery until it shaps into place - Replace and secure the battery cover until it clicks into place.

Charge the phone



Connect the USB plug of the adaptor to the charging socket (A) or place the device in the cradle (B) and connect the latter to the mains with the provided power adaptor.

Talking Dialing Digits

While pressing the numeric buttons, D38 will announce the corresponding number.

(Press Menu > Settings > Profiles > General > Customize > Keypad..... to select among Talking dialing digits, Silence or Key tone.)

Talking Caller ID Name

You can record a name/message associated to the PHOTO phonebook contacts. When the incoming caller number matches the phone number in the photo phonebook, the corresponding recorded name/message will be announced instead of the normal ring melody.

(Press > View > Edit > Caller ringtone >..... to delete the recorded message and restore the normal ringtone)

Remember to set **Helper** mobile phone number for SMS alert notification for i.Ringer, s.Notification and Smart Care.

Intelligent Ringer

- In order not to miss a call, the ringer loudness will automatically set to maximum when the same phone number calls the second time within 3 minutes after the initial missed call.
- After the call is answered, the ringer loudness will be resumed to the user selected volume level.

(Press Menu > S > i.Ringer.....to switch this feature ON/OFF)

Smart Notification

SMS will be sent to the **Helper** (Mobile phone number) for MISSED CALL (1 to 10 missed call configurable) or BATTERY LOW of your phone.

Helper mobile phone number can be set under the same Smart

Smart Care

SMS will be sent to the **Helper** (Mobile phone number) for **LACK** of PHONE CALL ACTIVITIES or LACK of PHYSICAL ACTIVITIES (key detect, open/close of the phone, charging detection).

Helper mobile phone number can be set under the same Smart Tools menu.

Auto Answer

D38 answers incoming calls automatically in speakerphone mode at maximum volume when incoming calls of one of the authorized Care Taker phone numbers (Maximum of 5 preset phone numbers) are not answered the 3rd time within 3 minutes.

SOS bracelet option

- 1. Activate Bluetooth on D38: Press Menu > Network > Bluetooth > Power ON / Visibility ON.
- 2. Pair SOS bracelet : Menu > Network > Bluetooth > Pairing...
- 3. Use SOS bracelet: SOS number has to be registered in D38 (see SOS number setting)...

PROBLEMS AND SOLUTIONS

Problems	Solutions
The mobile phone cannot be switched on	No battery inserted; Battery is not charged.
The phone is requesting a PUK when I switch on the phone	If you do not have the PUK for your SIM card, please contact your service provider.
No signal quality is displayed	No network connection. The mobile phone is in a location where there is no network service, please move to a different location or contact your service provider
A message appears in the display for some functions, indicating execution/ use is not possible	Some functions can only be used after the respective service has been applied for. Contact your service provider.
Screen frozen or no response when pressing keys	Remove the battery for 3 minutes and try again
No connection to the mobile telecommunication network	Contact your service provider
The "Insert SIM" message appears in the display	Ensure that the SIM card has been installed correctly. Contact your service provider.
The battery cannot be charged or is empty within a short time	Battery is defective; Place the phone correctly in the charging unit or connect the charging unit properly; Clean the charging contact of the mobile phone and charging unit with a dry soft cloth; Charge the mobile phone for 4 hours.
The mobile phone has accidentally got wet	Switch off the phone immediately, remove the battery and allow the unit to dry completely before powering it on again.

TIPS ON THE BATTERY

- Only use batteries, cables and charging unit approved by the manufacturer, otherwise the battery could be damaged.
- Do not short circuit the battery. Always leave the battery in the phone to avoid accidentally short circuiting the battery contacts.
- Keep the battery contacts clean and free of dirt.
- The battery can be charged/discharged hundreds of times but its service life is limited. Replace the battery when the battery power has decreased noticeably
