Creating Formees

Drag and drop forms to make a formee, and drag and drop from the color palette to color it. When a form is selected on the drawing board, you can tap / to see different options and tap All to see all options at once. When you are finished creating a formee, tap Done to bring it to life.

Catalog

Use the catalog to buy new forms and copy existing formees.

Form Categories

Transformation Tools

Use these tools to copy, reshape, resize, and rotate forms.

Color Palette

Magnifying Glass

Tap to zoom in on a form that's selected on the drawing board. You can then change the zoom with and move around with . Tap to return to normal view.

Menu

Tap here to open a menu that contains lots of helpful creation tools.

Reading QR Code Patterns

Select Play, then Use AR Card & QR Code Tools, then Read a QR Code, and then use the outer cameras to read a QR Code. You can save any formees that you find as guests on your planet.



Connecting with Other Players

StreetPass™

You can exchange formees and images with other players by using the StreetPass feature. Content that you receive from other players will appear in your mailbox.

Note: You can restrict StreetPass functionality via Parental Controls. For more information, refer to the Nintendo 3DS™ Operations Manual.

Formee Playhouse

Play with up to three friends and make formees together. Players without the software can join in using Download Play.

Note: Each player must have his or her own Nintendo 3DS system in order to participate.

- If you continue to have any of the above symptoms, stop playing and see a doctor.
