To Operate

- To turn on the calculator, press the **C/CE** key.
- To clear an error during calculations, press the **C/CE** key once.
- To clear the display, press the **C/CE** key twice.
- The calculator will turn off after approximately seven minutes of inactivity.

C/CE Turn unit on / Clear Display / Clear Entry.

AC All Clear.

M+ Adds displayed amount to memory.

M- Subtracts displayed amount from memory.

MRC Recalls memory content.

% Calculates percentage.

X Calculates Multiplication.

+ Calculates Addition.

÷ Calculates Division.

- Calculates Subtraction.

= Enables Summation.

+/- Changes the displayed value to + or -.

MU Calculates Markup.

M/EXCH Changes to Exchange Mode.

TAX+ Calculates price plus tax.

TAX- Calculates price before tax.

SET Sets tax rate.

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Battery Handling and Usage

To Replace the Battery

- Remove the screw in the battery compartment cover.

- Remove spent button battery. Insert a fresh button cell (LR1130 or equivalent) **observing the proper polarity (+/-)** with the "+" side up. Failure to properly align the battery polarity can cause personal injury and /or property damage.
- Replace battery compartment cover and screw in place.

Care and Maintenance

- Never use paint thinner, benzene, or other volatile agents to clean the calculator, as these materials will remove printed markings and damage the case.
- Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the exterior of the calculator.
- Clean the plastic parts with a mild soap and a damp cloth or sponge if needed.
- Never use liquids or abrasive cleaners to clean this product.
- To avoid damage to this product, do not immerse it in water or other liquids.
