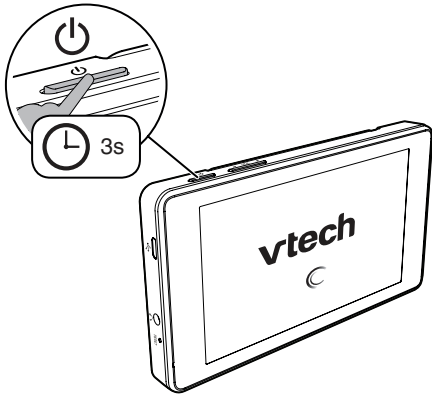


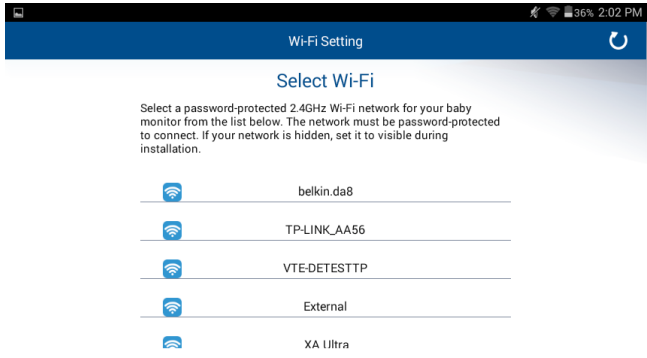
1 Set up Wi-Fi connection



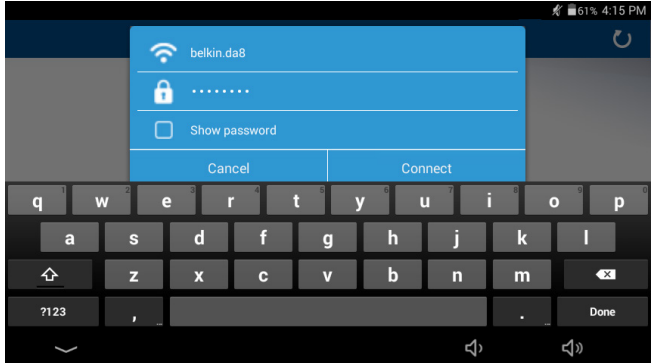
1 After the parent unit is fully charged, power on the parent unit.



2 Tap to select your preferred and secured Wi-Fi network with good signal strength.

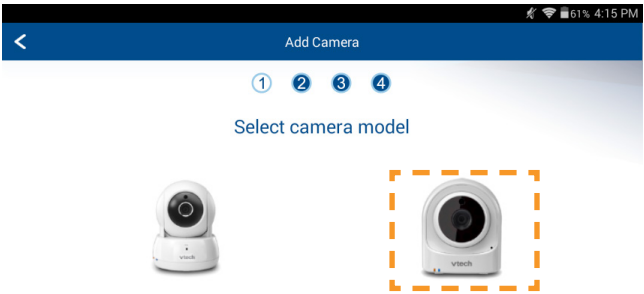


3 Type in the password of the Wi-Fi network, and then tap **Connect**.

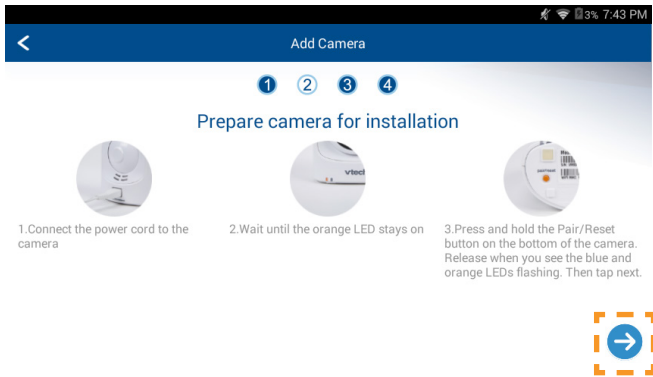


2 Add camera

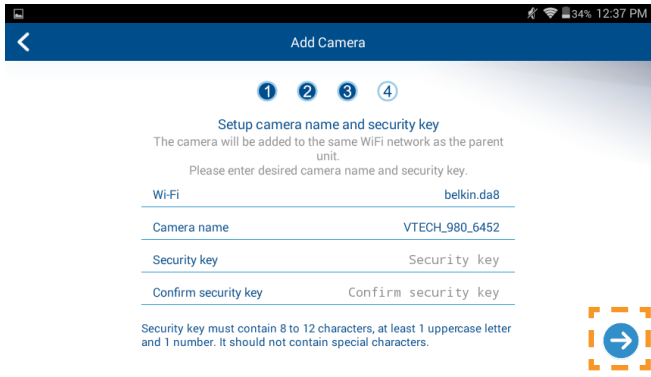
1 After connecting the parent unit to your Wi-Fi network, tap to select the VM981 camera.



2 Follow the instructions shown on screen, then tap →.



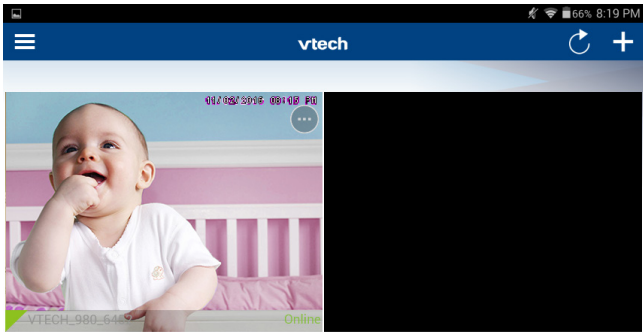
3 • Enter a security key for the camera. Repeat entering the security key to confirm. The security key must contain 8 to 12 alphanumeric characters with at least one uppercase character and one number.
• Tap → to continue.



NOTE

• Write down or remember the security key. You will need to provide the same security key if you want to access your camera remotely.

4 After the camera unit is successfully added to your parent unit, the camera list displays the preview of your camera unit.
• The camera list displays two camera previews. If you have more than two camera units, swipe to left shows more of your camera units.

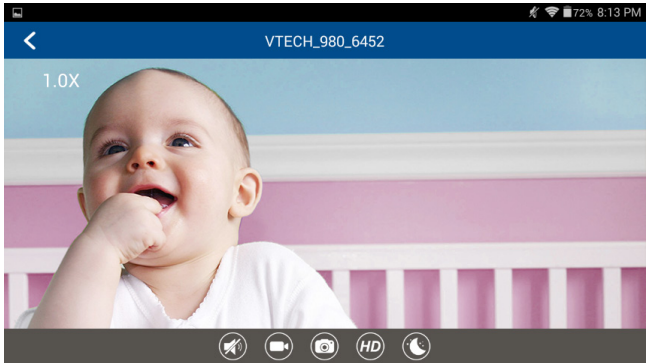

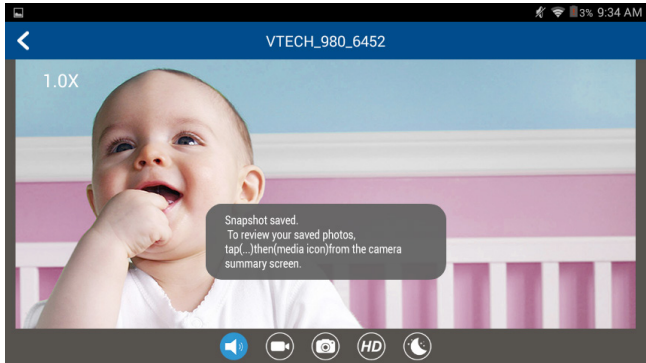
• The camera preview will be refreshed every second.

Basic operation

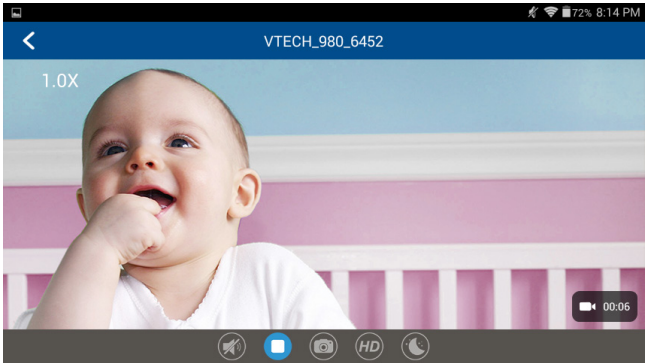
View the live camera
Tap the camera view on the camera list to go to its live view.



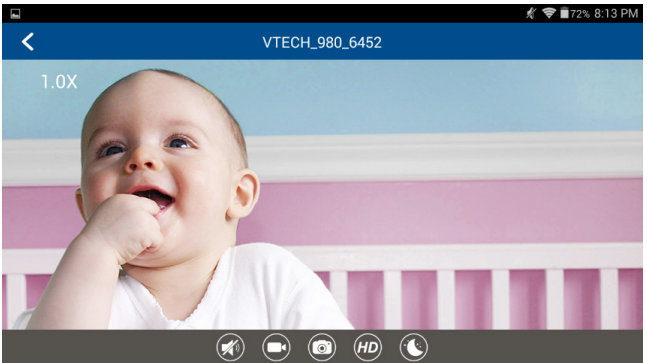
Take a snapshot
Tap 📷 to take a snapshot and save it in the parent unit.



Record a video
Tap 📹 to record a video and save it in the parent unit. The icon changes to 📹 when recording. Tap it to stop recording.



Play or mute sound
Tap 🔊 to toggle between play sound or mute sound transmitted from the camera when streaming.
• Make sure the parent unit's speaker volume is not muted.

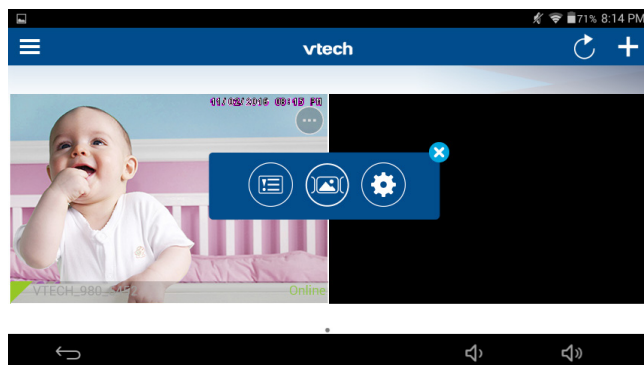




Basic operation

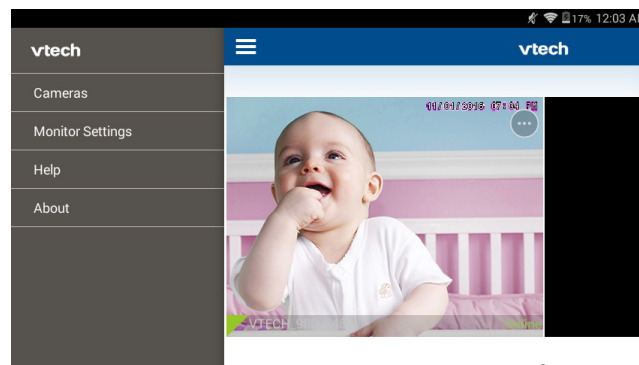
Camera settings

On the camera list, tap of a camera, and then tap to go to its camera settings.



Parent unit settings

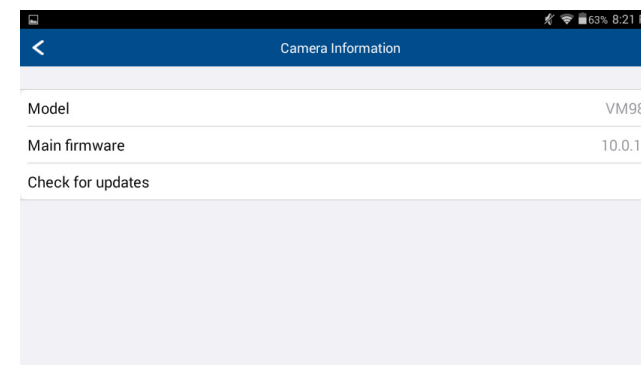
On the camera list, tap and then tap **Monitor Settings** to go to the parent unit settings.



Update software and camera firmware

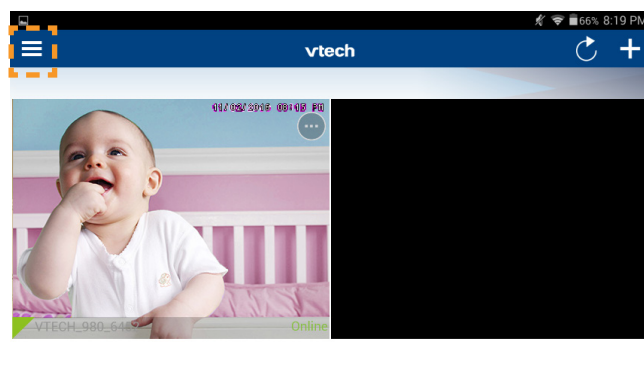
To ensure that your HD video monitor is always at its best performance, check for the camera's firmware updates and the parent unit's software updates from time to time.

- In **Camera settings**, scroll to and tap **Camera information**, then tap **Check for updates** and follow instructions.
- To check for latest software updates, tap and then tap **Help**. Then, tap **Check updates** and follow instructions.

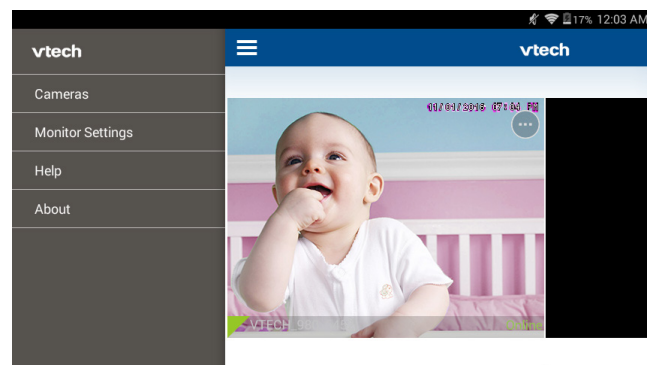

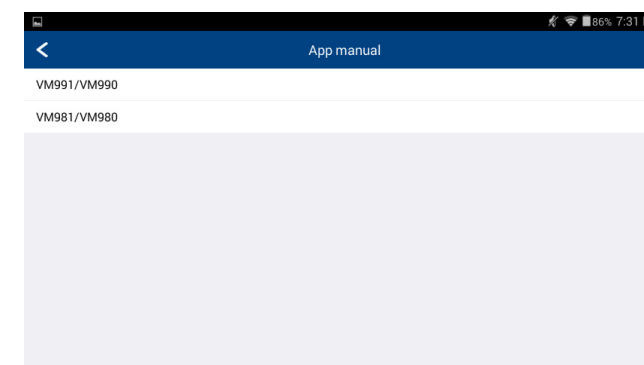

Remote monitoring

- 1 Download the free **MyVTech Baby** mobile app from the App Store or Google Play® store and install it to a mobile device, then you can use your mobile device and the mobile app to monitor your areas remotely.



NOTE

- Make sure your mobile device meets the minimum requirement for the mobile app.

Minimum requirement

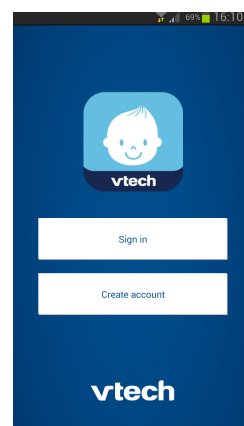
The mobile app is compatible with:

- Android® 4.4 or later; and
- iOS 8.0 or later.

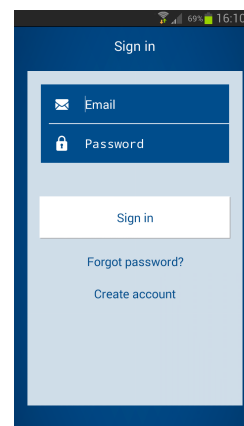
Install MyVTech Baby mobile app

1. Browse the App Store or the Google Play store .
2. Search for the mobile app with the keyword “myvtech baby”.
3. Download and install the **MyVTech Baby** mobile app to your mobile device.

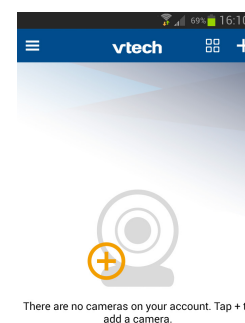
- 2 Tap to run the mobile app on your mobile device, and then create a user account.



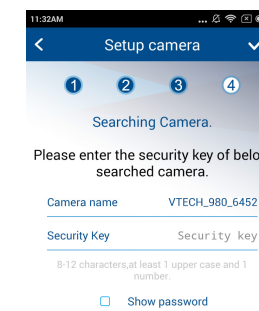
- 3 Verify your account via the email link, then sign in to your account.



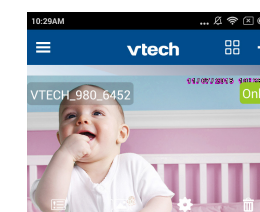
- 4 Follow the instructions on the screen to add the camera to your mobile account.
 - Make sure your mobile device is connected to the Wi-Fi network that your parent unit has connected to when adding the camera.



- 5 Type in the security key you have set for the camera with your parent unit. See Step 4 in **2 Add camera** section.



- 6 Start using your monitoring system remotely.



NOTES

- You must complete the camera setup in the above **1 Set up Wi-Fi network** and **2 Add camera** sections before you can access your camera remotely.
- Tap on the camera list to display the side menu, and then tap **Help** to refer to the online mobile app manual for the complete operation instructions.
